**Note:** For the purpose of admittance to Hinds Community College, students may submit transcripts in either of the following ways:

- 1) **Course-by-course** evaluation OR
- 2) **Document** evaluation PLUS copies of high school transcripts in English.(RECOMMENDED)

## FAQ

**Q: Do I need to have my transcript evaluated?**

Anyone who has attended high school outside of the United States must send their transcripts to an evaluation service in the United States for evaluation (and translation, if necessary). Transcripts for students entering Hinds Community College directly from high school **must** state that the student has graduated and **must** reflect a graduation date. The evaluation service is at the expense of the student.

**Q: Where should I ask the evaluation company to send my transcript?**

International students (those needing an I-20 document to request a student visa in order to attend classes) should have their transcripts directed to:

**Q: What type of evaluation is required?**

**NOTE:** *Hinds does not give credit for any college work done outside of the U.S., although transfer colleges after Hinds may give credit. NOTE: Hinds Admissions will accept a course-by-course evaluation OR a document evaluation, but copies of high school transcripts (in English) must be submitted to Hinds if a document only evaluation is used.*

**Q: What if I have already attended another college in the United States?**

International students transferring from accredited institutions within the United States must provide **official copies** of transcripts from all colleges/universities or high schools attended within the U.S., and such transcripts **must be sent directly from the college or university** to the Admissions Office at Hinds.
