| Reporting Year | Program Completion | Number of Students |

| 2017 | 100% | 6/6 students entering the final half of the graduated in 2017. This number includes 1 deferral student. |
| 2018 | 100% | 12/12 students entering the final half of the program graduated in 2018. This number includes 1 deferral student that completed the program March 2019. |
| 2019 | 89% | 8/ 9 students entering the final half of the program graduated 2019. 2 students graduated spring 2020. |
