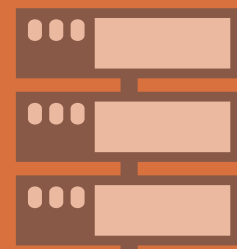


7 DASHBOARD MUST-HAVES
