San Franciscans **speak more than 100 languages** and nearly 50% of residents are foreign born, according to SFChamber.com.



San Francisco had its largest population boom from 1848 to 1849, when the Gold Rush sparked a staggering **2,400% growth in population**.



The Bay Area ranks #4 in the U.S. for being the most educated population with **49% having at least a bachelor's degree**.



San Francisco is a "green" city. In 2009, the city became the first in the U.S. to make **composting and recycling mandatory**.
