Training Location Information

The campus is on Broad Street between Washington Blvd and Franklin St. There will be signs posted in the main hallway and elevators to help guide the attendees to the classroom. Please arrive 10-15 minutes prior to class to allow yourself time to park and locate the classroom.

Parking Information

Parking is available at the Target garage (\$1 for 1st hour, \$2 for each consecutive hour) and the City of Stamford's Summer Street garage (\$1 per hour). The Summer St. garage can be accessed from the same entrance as the Target garage except you will proceed straight instead of turning right to go up the ramp to Target.

Alternate Transportation

- **<u>CTRides</u>**: The Connecticut Department of Transportation wants to help you find the best way to work. CTRides is DOT's centralized commuting resource.
- **CT Transit**: The #13 West Broad Street bus has stops at both the Stamford train station and the Stamford Campus. Bus fare is \$1.50 (as of 1/19/14).
- <u>Harbor Point Trolley</u>: The Harbor Point Trolley links the South End to Downtown and there's stop on Broad street on the opposite side of the campus. The route runs 7 days a week in a 14-stop, 30-minute clockwise loop. UConn Stamford campus is Stop #5 on its route.
- Walking to Campus: The campus is a 12-minute walk from the Stamford Transportation Center. Take Washington Blvd. to walk directly North to the campus on Broad Street.
- Taxi: Taxis are available at the Stamford Transportation Center.
- Train: Both Metro North and Amtrak stations are available at the Stamford Transportation Center.
