New Treatment for Varicose Veins

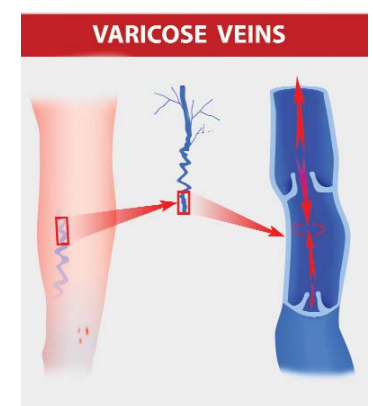
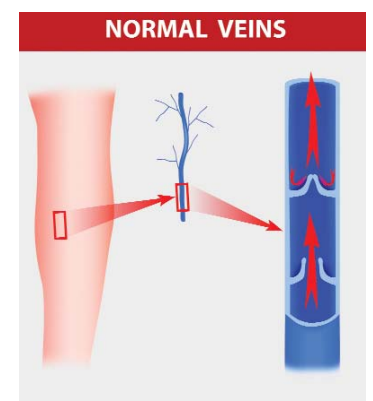

Interventional cardiologist Dr. Deepak Thekkoot is one of the first to offer the VenaSeal non-surgical varicose vein treatment in the Greater Baton Rouge area.

Traditional treatment for varicose veins involve painful local anesthesia, but the VenaSeal treatment is almost painless because after the area is numbed, it is done under ultrasound guidance and uses a medical-grade adhesive injected directly into the vein to close the greater and lesser saphenous veins in the legs.

This unique approach eliminates post-procedure pain and bruising and the need for post-procedure compression stockings. The treatment is designed to allow patients a rapid return to normal activities.

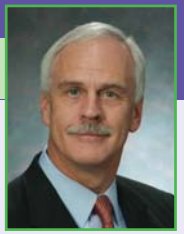

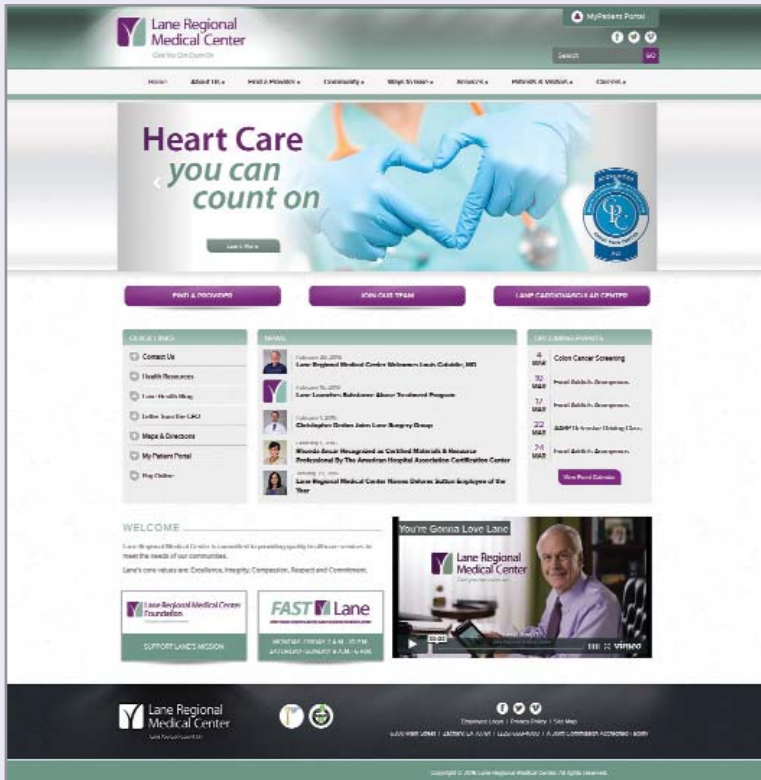

2 weeks to 3 months after quitting	Your circulation improves and your lung function increases
1 to 9 months after quitting	Coughing and shortness of breath decrease; cilia (tiny hair-like structures that move mucus out of the lungs) regain normal function, increasing the ability to clean the lungs and reduce the risk of infection

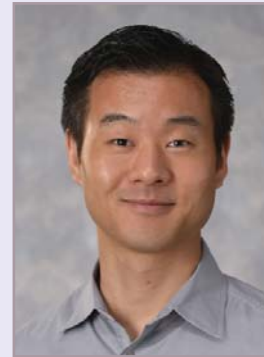

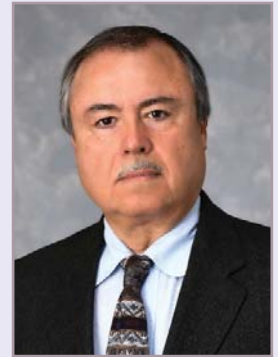
Auxiliary Appreciation Breakfast
