ATPI Alerts Travel Restrictions per Country due to Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

Countries all over the world are implementing travel bans and restrictions in an effort to limit the spread of the COVID pandemic outbreak. Below you may find the most recent bans in short. Note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information are based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

1. **Ukraine:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports Ukrainian International Airlines is operating a direct flight from Kyiv to New York City on 25 March during COVID-19 concerns
2. **Moldova, Romania:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports air traffic in Moldova suspended until at least 1 April; airport in Bucharest continues to operate with limited options during COVID-19 concerns
3. **France:** Lille-Lesquin Airport will close for passenger flights from 23 March because of COVID-19
4. **France:** Update: More than 20 mayors impose curfews in their areas to fight spread of COVID-19 during existing nationwide ban on nonessential commercial activities
5. **Denmark:** Update: Nationwide lockdown continues until 13 April
6. **Estonia:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports possibility of flight suspensions out of Tallinn Airport from 27 March amid COVID-19 concerns
7. **Hungary:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy compiling list of persons seeking to leave country due to COVID-19
8. **U.K.:** All flights to, from Teesside International Airport will be suspended from 24 March because of COVID-19 outbreak
9. **Cyprus:** Government announces lockdown through 13 April to halt spread of COVID-19
10. **U.K.:** Government imposes lockdown to combat spread of COVID-19

ASIAN /AUSTRALIA COUNTRIES:

11. **China:** All inbound flights scheduled to land at Beijing Capital International Airport will be redirected from 23 March for passenger health checks and quarantine
12. **Kazakhstan:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports some airline carriers still operating limited flights into and out of Almaty or Nur-Sultan during COVID-19 concerns

13. **India:** Update: All domestic passenger flights suspended until 31 March because of COVID-19
14. **Bangladesh:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports limited outgoing commercial flights are still available from Dhaka airport
15. **Philippines:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports 'sweeper' flights out of Cebu may be available on 24 March amid COVID-19 concerns
16. **Pakistan:** Update: Sindh and Punjab provinces announce lockdown as military deployed countrywide to contain COVID-19 spread
17. **Pakistan:** CDC warns against nonessential travel because of COVID-19
18. **Papua New Guinea:** Update: Two week state of emergency declared from 24 March to halt spread of COVID-19
19. **China, Hong Kong, Macau:** Government announces new restrictions for visitors from Hong Kong, China
20. **China:** Outbound travel restrictions in Wuhan to be lifted from 8 April; other cities in Hubei province to remove inbound, outbound travel restrictions from 25 March
21. **Kyrgyz Republic:** Country imposes lockdowns, curfews in Bishkek, Osh and Jalal-Abad to curb spread of COVID-19

LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

22. **Cuba:** Government partially closes borders because of COVID-19 outbreak

AFRICAN / MIDDLE EAST COUNTRIES:

23. **Uganda:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy tells U.S. nationals Qatar Airways will operate a flight from Entebbe to Doha on 25 March
24. **Kenya:** All international flights will be suspended from 25 March because of COVID-19
25. **Rwanda:** Update: Authorities impose shutdown, close all borders because of COVID-19 concerns
26. **Ghana:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports impending closure of Accra's Kotoka International Airport because of COVID-19, possible repatriation efforts for U.S. nationals
27. **Guinea:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports closure of Conakry's Gbessia International Airport because of COVID-19
28. **United Arab Emirates:** Update: All passenger flights will be suspended for two weeks from 25 March because of COVID-19 concerns
29. **South Sudan:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports government implements enhanced screening and quarantine measures because of COVID-19 concerns
30. **Afghanistan:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy urges U.S. nationals to leave as commercial flights are limited
31. **DR Congo:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports a flight from Kinshasa to Washington Dulles Airport may be available on 25 or 26 March amid COVID-19 concerns
32. **Sudan:** Government imposes nationwide curfew every night from 24 March to fight COVID-19 spread
33. **South Africa:** Government to impose 21-day nationwide lockdown from 26 March to contain COVID-19 outbreak
34. **Iraq:** Update: Suspension of commercial flights extended to, from all airports until 28 March because of COVID-19
35. **Algeria:** Government imposes curfew in Algiers, full lockdown in Blida because of COVID-19
36. **Nigeria:** Government closes land borders to curb spread of COVID-19
37. **Cote d'Ivoire, Senegal:** Governments impose curfews, travel restrictions because of COVID-19
38. **South Africa:** International flights to Johannesburg's Lanseria Airport to be suspended because of COVID-19

USA/ CANADA:

39. **U.S.:** Update: Washington state announces lockdown of non-essential services to halt spread of COVID-19
40. **U.S.:** Update: A dozen more states issue stay-at-home orders to slow spread of COVID-19
41. **U.S:** Update: Atlanta, Georgia, issues 14-day stay-at-home order because of COVID-19 outbreak

AIRLINES:

42. **Austria: Austrian Airlines** extends suspension of all regular flight operations until 19 April
43. **Nicaragua: Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports Spirit Airlines** will suspend Managua flights beginning 24 March, **American** from 27 March, **United** beginning 1 April due to COVID
44. **Greenland: Air Greenland** cancels all operations until at least 4 April because of COVID-19
45. **Mexico: Update: AeroMexico** reduces international, domestic flights by 35 and 50 percent because of COVID-19
46. **Greece:** Update: **Aegean Airlines** will suspend all international flights from 26 March through 30 April because of COVID-19
47. **Malta:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports **Air Malta** will schedule outbound flights to some European cities beginning on 23 March amid COVID-19 concerns
48. **U.S.: Update: Southwest Airlines** will reduce flights by 20 percent until 5 June because of COVID-19
49. **Chile: SKY** suspends all flights until 30 April because of COVID-19
50. **United Arab Emirates: Etihad Airways** to suspend all flights to, from Abu Dhabi International Airport because of COVID-19
51. **U.K.: British Airways** suspends all flights at London City Airport because of COVID-19
