## ATPI Alerts Travel Restrictions per Country due to Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

Countries all over the world are implementing travel bans and restrictions in an effort to limit the spread of the COVID pandemic outbreak. Below you may find the most recent bans in short. Note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information are based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

### EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

1. **Italy, Romania, Spain:** Update: Romania prolongs suspension of Italy, Spain flights for 14 days because of COVID-19
2. **Ireland:** Cork Airport joins Dublin Airport and reduces operations amid COVID-19 concerns; flights planned to repatriate stranded Irish nationals
3. **Poland:** Update: Country will impose further restrictions on public life, including closing hotels to curb spread of COVID-19
4. **Belgium:** Update: Brussels Charleroi Airport may partially resume its commercial activities from 3 May
5. **Bulgaria:** Update: Stara Zagora province imposes night curfew to fight COVID-19
6. **France:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy in Paris reports emergency passport service hours, advises U.S. nationals to return home because of COVID-19

### ASIAN /AUSTRALIA COUNTRIES:

7. **Armenia:** Update: Country extends emergency restrictions for another 10 days in effort to curb spread of COVID-19
8. **Vietnam:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy advises government calls for maximum social distancing starting 1 April to reduce spread of COVID-19

### LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

9. **Chile:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports about travel restrictions, quarantine measures because of COVID-19; some commercial flights still available
10. **Argentina:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports there are still seats remaining on repatriation flight for citizens on 2 April because of COVID-19

### **AFRICAN / MIDDLE EAST COUNTRIES:**

11. **Equatorial Guinea:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy tells U.S. nationals that repatriation flight on 31 March has been canceled
12. **Botswana:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports government to implement lockdown beginning 2 April because of COVID-19
13. **Tunisia:** Update: Government extends lockdown until 19 April to contain spread of COVID-19
14. **United Arab Emirates:** Update: Government revokes permit system to move around during nightly curfews amid COVID-19 outbreak
15. **Uganda:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy advises Qatar Airways flight available for U.S. citizens on 3 April because of COVID-19
16. **Nigeria:** Security Message: U.S. Consulate General confirms several evacuation flights planned because of COVID-19
17. **Sierra Leone:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports first confirmed case of COVID-19; state of emergency declared
18. **Guinea:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports about enhanced screening, quarantine measures because of COVID-19; curfew imposed

### **NORTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES:**

19. **U.S.:** Update: Amtrak reduces, suspends services in several regions because of COVID-19
20. **Jamaica:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports curfew will go into effect on 1 April because of COVID-19; some repatriation flights scheduled
21. **Honduras:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports about new restrictions imposed because of COVID-19
22. **Cuba:** Update: Country suspends arrival of international flights amid COVID-19 outbreak

### **AIRLINES:**

23. **Europe:** Croatia Airlines reduces its network to just four routes from Zagreb because COVID-19 outbreak
24. **U.S.:** Update: Southwest Airlines will cut more than 40 percent of flights from 3 May through 5 June because of COVID-19
25. **U.S.:** JetBlue Airways cuts flights by 80 percent from New York area because of COVID-19
26. **Pakistan:** Update: PIA to partially restore international flights from 2 April after suspension because of COVID-19
27. **Qatar:** Qatar Airways decreases flights by more than 75 percent after COVID-19 outbreak
28. **Mexico:** Volaris airline to reduce capacity during April because of COVID-19 outbreak
