ATPI Alerts Travel Restrictions per Country due to Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Dear Valued Client,

Countries all over the world are implementing travel bans and restrictions in an effort to limit the spread of the COVID pandemic outbreak. Below you may find the most recent updates in short. Note that unexpected travel cancellations are taking place and airlines status may change at any given time without prior notice. The enlisted information are based on the officially announced governmental travel restrictions and quarantine measures.

Below is a summary of the latest updates, please be aware it is not a complete overview of all current travel bans and restrictions.

Areas & airports opening or softening restrictions

1. **Belgium, Rwanda:** Update: RwandAir to operate weekly Brussels repatriation flights from May after nationwide grounding because of COVID-19
2. **Austria, Hungary:** Update: Wizz Air to resume Vienna flights from 1 May
3. **Hong Kong, India:** Update: Cathay Pacific Airways to resume Hong Kong-Delhi flights from 6 May
4. **Malaysia: Malindo Air** to resume domestic flights from 27 April after COVID-19 lockdown prompts cancellations
5. **South Africa:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports emergency level will decrease on 1 May; government announces measures to gradually lift COVID-19 lockdown; some restrictions continue
6. **Fiji:** Update: **Fiji Link** resumes daily flights to, from Labasa as travel restrictions lifted
7. **United Arab Emirates:** Update: **Etihad Airways** plans to resume passenger flights on 16 May as COVID-19 forces suspension
8. **Europe:** Update: **Wizz Air** to resume some flights from London's Luton Airport on 1 May
9. **India:** Update: Government announces easing of COVID-19 lockdown restrictions
10. **Slovakia:** Update: Government lifts COVID-19 quarantine from Bystrany
11. **Philippines:** Update: Government announces relaxed COVID-19 quarantine measures from 1 May
12. **Israel, U.S.:** Update: **Delta Airlines** to resume flights between Tel Aviv and New York from 10 May after COVID-19 suspension

13. **Europe, Israel:** Update: **Wizz Air** to resume some flights to London, Tel Aviv and Vienna in May after COVID-19 suspension
14. **Serbia, U.K.:** Update: **Wizz Air** resumes flights between Belgrade and London Luton from 1 May
15. **Thailand:** Update: Suvarnabhumi Airport in Bangkok to reopen for domestic flights from 1 May after COVID-19 forces closure
16. **Global:** Update: **Delta Air Lines** releases list of international services that will begin in May
17. **Kazakhstan:** Update: Government to ease some COVID-19 restrictions; flights between Nur-Sultan and Almaty to resume from 1 May
18. **Turkey:** Update: Government lifts COVID-19 quarantines for more than half of affected areas
19. **Canada, Europe, India, Israel:** Update: **British Airways** delays restart to Tel Aviv until 16 May as other airlines plan to resume; **Wizz Air** will fly to 15 destinations from its Luton hub starting 1 May
20. **Rwanda:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports option to request permission for essential movements amid COVID-19 concerns
21. **Panama:** Update: **Copa Airlines** plans to restart operations from 1 June
22. **Bosnia and Herzegovina:** Serb Republic region loosens restrictions imposed to curb spread of COVID-19
23. **Nigeria:** Update: President announces phased and gradual easing of lockdowns imposed because of COVID-19 in Lagos, Abuja on 4 May
24. **Jordan:** Update: Government eases curfew imposed because of COVID-19
25. **Croatia:** Update: **Croatia Airlines** releases domestic flight schedule that will resume on 11 May
26. **New Zealand:** Update: Month-long COVID-19 lockdown ends; certain businesses remain closed

Areas & airports imposing further restrictions

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES:

1. **Serbia:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports on travel and transit restrictions imposed by government to prevent spread of COVID-19
2. **Croatia:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports on entrance and movement restrictions imposed by government to prevent spread of COVID-19
3. **Macedonia:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports on curfew, other restrictions imposed by government of North Macedonia to prevent spread of COVID-19
4. **Italy:** Update: Borders will stay closed to foreign tourists until end of year because of COVID-19
5. **U.K.:** Update: Officials consider 14 days of quarantine for all passengers flying into airports in bid to halt second peak of COVID-19 infections; possible start in May
6. **Israel:** Update: Non-nationals will not be allowed to enter country until 16 May because of COVID-19
7. **Turkey:** Update: President imposes three-day lockdown in 31 cities from 1 May because of COVID-19; weekend lockdowns will continue until late May

ASIAN /AUSTRALIA COUNTRIES:

1. **Philippines:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports on extension of community quarantine in several regions through 15 May

2. **Pakistan:** Update: Government extends nationwide lockdown until 9 May to curb spread of COVID-19
3. **Myanmar:** Update: Yangon International Airport extends ban on international flight arrivals until 15 May because of COVID-19
4. **Nepal:** Update: Government extends suspension of domestic, international flights until 15 May amid COVID-19 pandemic
5. **Sri Lanka:** Government reimposes 24-hour curfew because of COVID-19 outbreak
6. **Thailand:** Update: Civil Aviation Authority to extend ban on inbound international flights until end of May because of COVID-19; repatriation flights for Thai nationals to continue
7. **Myanmar:** Update: Government extends suspension of visas, commercial flights until 15 May to curb spread of COVID-19
8. **Australia:** Security Message: U.S. Consulate reports Queensland will relax restrictions from 2 May, Western Australia from 27 April amid COVID-19 concerns
9. **Azerbaijan:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy updates its information on travel restrictions caused by COVID-19
10. **Pakistan:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports international flights suspended until 15 May amid COVID-19 concerns

LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

1. **Argentina:** Update: COVID-19 lockdown in larger cities extended until 10 May; some restrictions loosened
2. **Argentina:** Update: Government bans ticket sales for commercial flights until September because of COVID-19
3. **Trinidad and Tobago:** Official Travel Advice: U.K. reports 'stay at home' order continues for nonessential labor force until at least 15 May

AFRICAN / MIDDLE EAST COUNTRIES:

1. **Iraq:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports on extension of flight suspension through 22 May
2. **Guinea:** Security Message: U.S. Embassy reports state of emergency and shelter-in-place directive extended because of COVID-19 outbreak; travel restrictions continue
3. **Angola:** Parliament extends state of emergency to stop spread of COVID-19; some restrictions relaxed
4. **Liberia:** Update: President extends COVID-19 related isolation measures until 8 May
5. **Lebanon:** Update: COVID-19 lockdown to be extended until 10 May
6. **Saudi Arabia:** Update: Government extends suspension of flights, public transport until further notice because of COVID-19
7. **Algeria:** Update: Government to extend movement restrictions until 14 May to limit spread of COVID-19

NORTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES:

1. **U.S.:** Flights from San Luis Obispo County Regional Airport to San Diego, Los Angeles temporarily suspended amid COVID-19 crisis

2. **Canada:** Update: Police continue to advise residents to 'shelter in place' after preliminary investigation finds no evidence of shots fired in two Halifax-area communities
3. **U.S.:** Update: **Hawaii** extends COVID-19 lockdown and quarantine through 31 May

AIRLINES:

1. **Turkmenistan:** **Turkmenistan Airlines** extends suspension of international flights until 20 May because of COVID-19
2. **Indonesia:** **Garuda Indonesia** temporarily suspends its domestic flights from 25 April because of COVID-19
3. **Poland:** Update: **PLL LOT airline** cancels flights until 15 May amid COVID-19 concerns
4. **Fiji:** Update: **Fiji Link** resumes daily flights to, from Labasa as travel restrictions lifted
5. **Singapore:** Update: **Singapore Airlines** extends flight cancellations to June amid COVID-19 outbreak
6. **Europe, Israel, U.S.:** Update: **El Al Israel Airlines** extends suspension of scheduled flights until 9 May, will operate some special rescue flights
7. **Norway:** Update: **Norwegian Air** planes set to remain grounded until April 2021 because of COVID-19
8. **Canada:** Update: **Porter Airlines** extends suspension of flights until 29 June because of COVID-19
9. **Belgium:** Update: TUI Belgium, **TUI fly Belgium** extend cancellation of trips, flights until 7 June because of COVID-19
