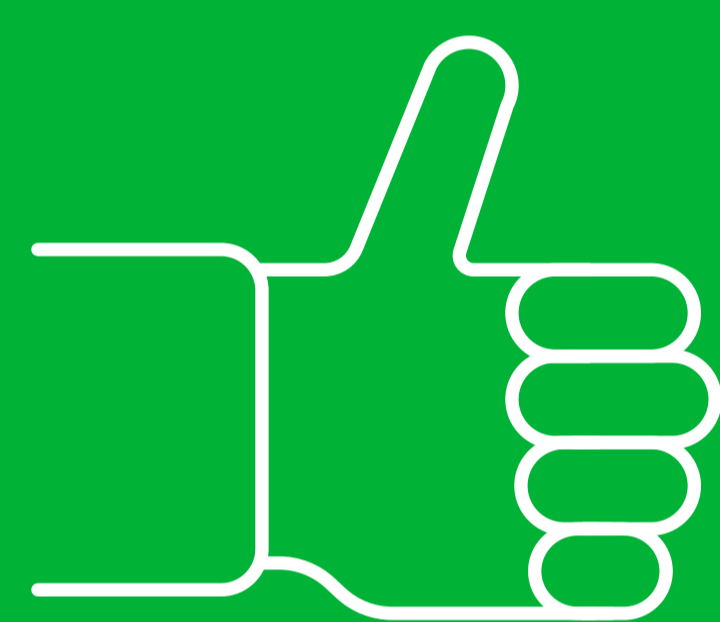

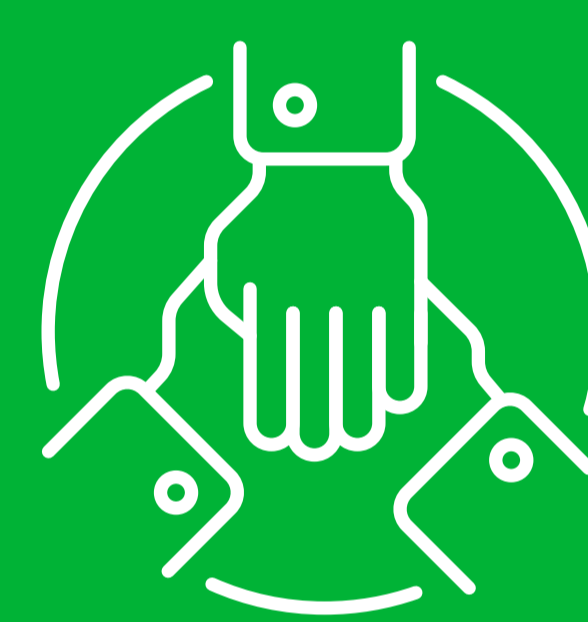

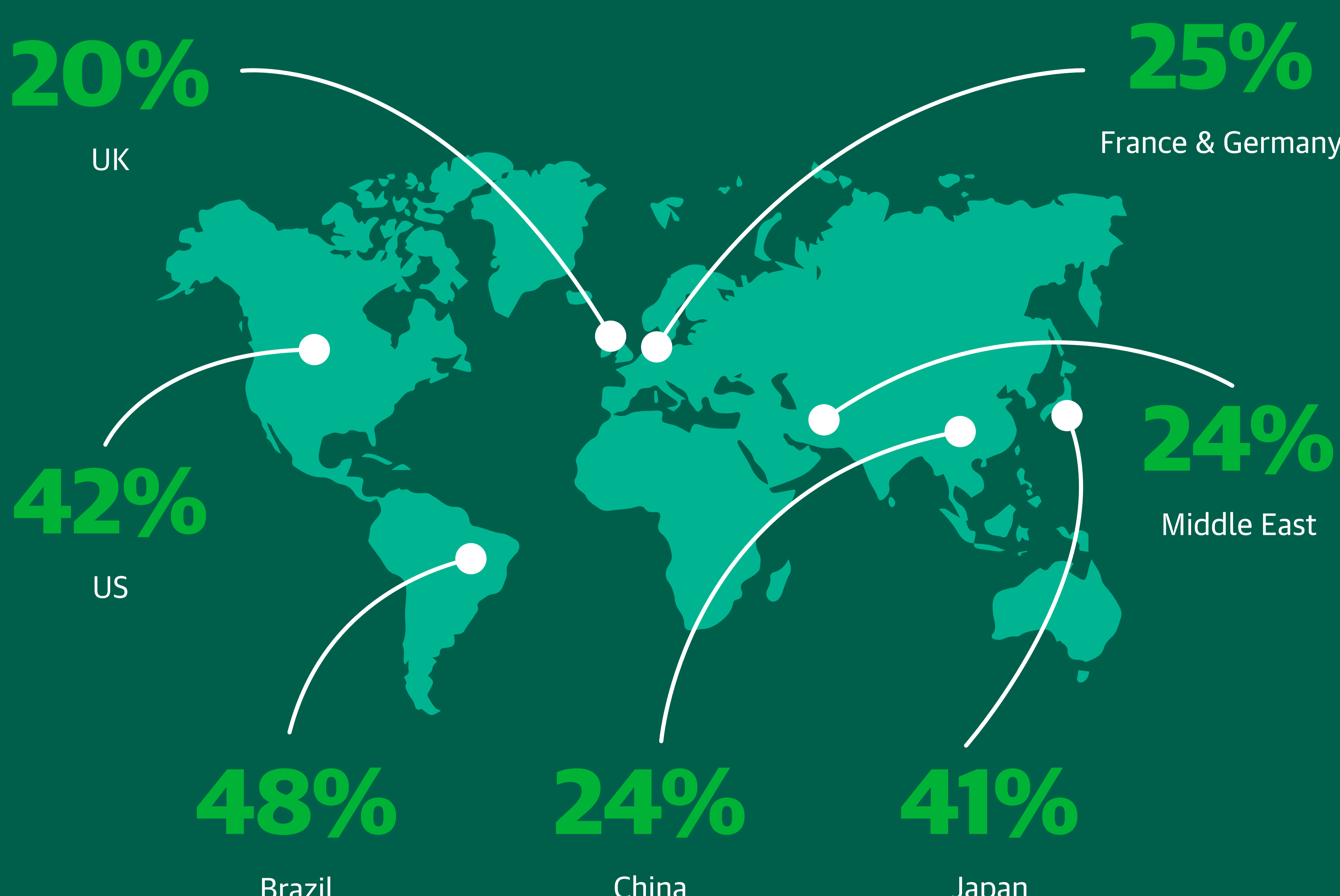

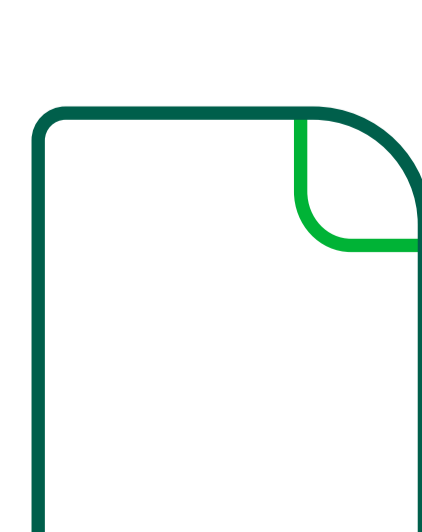
There's a global race for digital adoption
