

4 OPTIONS TO REPLACE MISSING TEETH

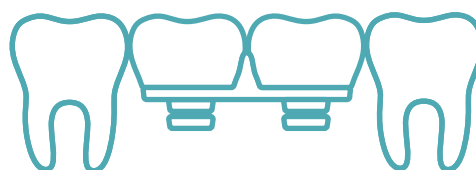
Restorative dentistry has many different treatment options to meet an assortment of needs, from financial to medical. Here's an overview of some of the most popular treatments for missing teeth:

DENTAL IMPLANTS



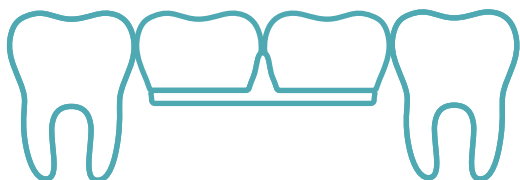
Dental implants are a permanent, durable solution to tooth loss that utilizes surgical posts infixed to your jawbone for maximum stability.

IMPLANT-SUPPORTED DENTURES



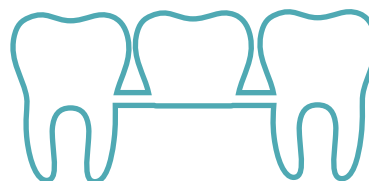
Implant-supported dentures feature one or more removable replacement teeth that attach to screws in the front of your jawbone.

REMOVABLE PARTIAL DENTURES



Removable partial dentures are a set of artificial teeth supported by an acrylic fixture that is made to look like your natural gums.

DENTAL BRIDGES



Dental bridges work by first filing down a small amount of enamel on your surrounding teeth, and then fixing the prosthesis with an attached replacement tooth to your healthy teeth.
