Therefore, we need to keep in mind that while this document indicates that Local and State Construction Offices are to remain open there may be situations where an LEA is closed for health and safety reasons. To continue as an essential construction project, documentation must be submitted to the local construction office attesting to how the project qualifies as an essential construction project and the measures/precautions put in place to satisfy Section #3 and #4 of the Executive Order. Sections #3 and #4 outline procedures and safety measures that must be implemented to ensure proper social distancing on site, personnel limitations, cleaning and disinfecting, etc. Construction offices may still accept permit applications for non-essential construction projects but may not issue the permit until E.O. 122 is lifted.
