1. A completed Saint Leo University Application for Admission as a Non Degree Seeking EPI student.
2. Official college transcripts from all colleges attended indicating the minimum of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution.
3. Evidence of background check and clearance from District/School in preparation for field experiences.
4. Statement of Status of Eligibility from the Florida Department of Education.
5. Passing score on the Florida Department of Education General Knowledge Exam (<http://www.fl.nesinc.com/tests.asp>).
6. Passing score on a Subject Area Exam in which the candidate is interested in obtaining a professional teaching certificate (<http://www.fl.nesinc.com/tests.asp>).
