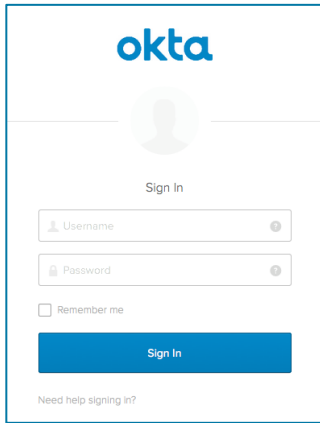


Multifactor authentication (MFA) provides an additional layer of security for your applications by adding another factor to the sign on process.

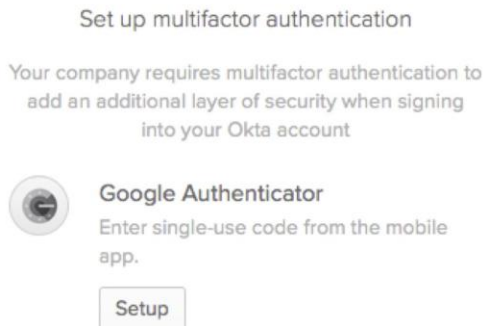
## Authenticating to Okta Using Google Authenticator

### Open a web browser

- 1 In the Address bar, type the name of your company Okta organization.  
For example: **abcompany.okta.com**

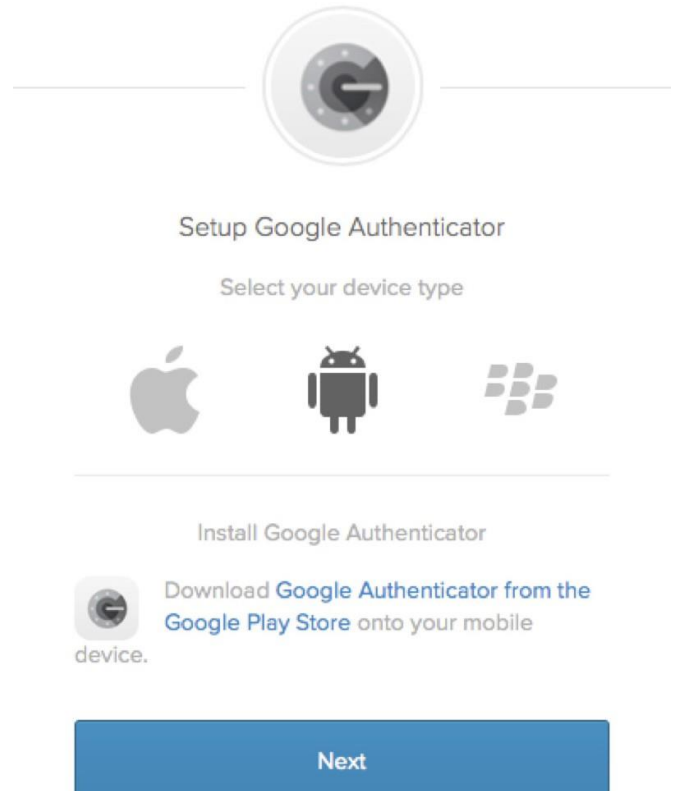


- 2 Type your company issued credentials and click Sign In.
- 3 On the Set up multifactor authentication screen, click Setup.



- 4 On the Setup Google Authenticator screen, click the device type icon.

- 5 Click **Next**.



### Install the Google Authenticator App

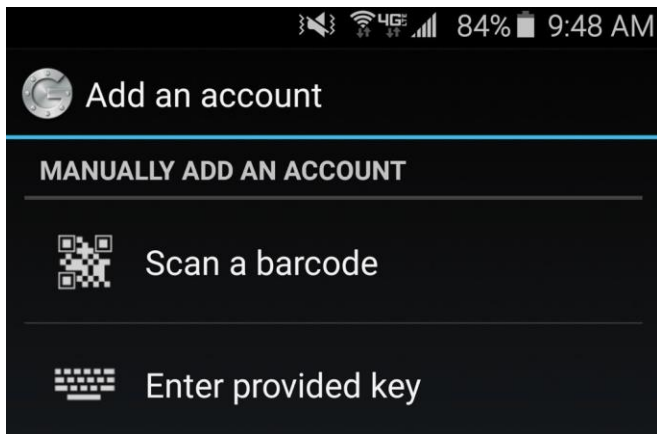
- 6 On your mobile device, open the app store.
  - On an iOS device open the Apple App Store.
  - On an Android device open the Google Play Store.

- 7 Search for and install Google Authenticator.



Enable 2-step verification to protect your

- 8 Open the Google Authenticator app.



- 9 Tap Scan a barcode. You might need to install the Barcode Scanner app; follow the prompts and then re-tap Scan a barcode.
- 10 Hold your device up to the computer screen and scan the barcode.
- 11 Click Next

### Complete the Okta Login

- 12 Type the Google Authenticator code appearing on your mobile device, into the Setup Google Authenticator screen on your computer and click Verify.
