LOG ALL THE THINGS

Logs can be sent via config changes to popular logging frameworks like log4net, NLog, Serilog and more!



DON'T SWEAT EXCEPTIONS

Retrace collects all exceptions automatically. Choose what you want to see: first chance exceptions, handled or unhandled exceptions.



TRACK EVERY SQL QUERY

Retrace tracks performance down to every unique SQL query, including dynamic SQL, stored procedures, and crazy ORM queries.



TRACK EVERY REQUEST

Retrace tracks every request, fast or slow, and provides sampled detailed traces of them.



LOGGING - WITH A PRICE

New Relic provides no support for application or server logs. Instead, it links you to (costly) 3rd party providers.



EXCEPTIONS GET A PASS

New Relic only tracks unhandled exceptions and only the last exception in a request. Any exceptions caught and thrown away will be hidden.



BASIC SQL REPORTING

Along with basic reporting on tracked SQL queries, get overly combined unique statements, making tracking a headache.



BASIC REPORTING. AGAIN.

New Relic only provides detailed traces for slow requests. This makes it hard to troubleshoot app problems that fail fast, or compare performance to fast requests.
