

Car Registration Form

Students must complete a Car Registration Form each school year and turn into the office. Forms are available in the school office, or by clicking on this link...Car Registration Form. Students who need a parking tag can purchase these in the school office (\$15 fee). Parking tags must be properly displayed when using the student parking lot, and the tag is valid as long as the student is at Martin Luther. If a student has lost their parking tag, they must purchase another one. Students, who obtain their drivers license during the school year must complete this form and purchase a parking tag.



PARENTS/GUARDIANS: PLEASE REVIEW THESE ATTENDANCE REMINDERS WITH YOUR STUDENT(S)

- Students are to be in their Advisory room by 8:00a.m. Parents, please ensure your student arrives to school by 7:45a.m. so they have time to go to their lockers and get to their Advisory room on time.
- Please report absences to the School Office by calling 421-4000, ext. 500 prior to **9:00a.m.** on the day of the absence.
- If a student arrives late or needs to leave due to a doctor/dentist appointment, a note from the doctor/dentist must be given to the office. Students who do not have a doctor/dentist note will have an unexcused absence.
- If it is necessary for a student to leave during school hours, a note signed by a parent must be given to the School Office before school starts, or a parent should call the School Office prior to **9:00a.m**. The student will be given a permit to leave campus. Failure to notify the office at least 1 hour prior to an early pick-up may result in a delayed dismissal.

• If, at any time during the school day, a student should become ill, he/she should report to the School Office immediately. The student's parent/guardian will be contacted and asked to give permission for the student to leave school.

Students are not to leave school during the day without reporting to the School Office for permission to leave.

SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2018-2019

INDIVIDUAL DEPARTMENT NEEDS:

Art - Supplies are provided in class. Graphic Design and Digital Imaging students need a digital camera and Ceramics - Composition Notebook or sketchbook.

Business/Technology - 3-ring binder, notebook paper, black and red pens.

English - <u>Literature & Writing</u>: 2 three-ring binders with dividers - One binder (with eight dividers) for daily use and the other (which needs to be a 1.5 inch binder with four dividers) is for the Novel Portfolio project, blue and black pens, as well as several red pens. Highlighters are helpful. <u>Comprehensive English</u>, One 3 ring binder with dividers, along with blue, black, and red pens. Highlighters are also helpful. <u>Creative Writing</u>, 3 or 5 subject notebook. <u>History of Drama</u>, 3-ring binder. <u>Modern Literature</u>, composition notebook. <u>Speech</u>, 3-ring binder, lined paper and index cards.

Family & Consumer Education - All classes need a three ring binder, loose leaf paper and a writing utensil. Covers for books are also required. Clothing Classes need an 8x10 white canvas or larger, sewing shears, colored buttons and at least 1 yard of cotton fabric in a print of your choice.

All Foods classes need a 3-ring binder. Clothing items are discussed at the beginning of class.

Foreign/World Language - Mandarin Chinese and Spanish require a 3-ring binder with dividers.

International Studies - Translator pen and bilingual dictionary, Beginning/ Intermediate Grammar: binder, notebook paper, 4 different color highlighters, black and red pens, dividers, scissors, and glue sticks. Vocabulary: binder, notebook paper, 4 different color highlighters, black and red pens, and dividers. SAT/ACT/TOEFL: binder, notebook paper, 4 different color highlighters, black and red pens, and dividers.

Mathematics - Large 3-ring binder, binder dividers, graph paper, pencils, large eraser, ruler, and a red pen are needed. Pre-Algebra requires a TI-30 calculator (please <u>avoid</u> Cascio brand if possible). All other classes (including Algebra, Honors Algebra and Geometry) require a TI-84 graphics calculator.

Physical Education - Students need to provide their own workout apparel and tennis shoes. Locks are provided.

Science - All science classes require a 1.5" or larger binder with dividers, notebook paper, graph paper, pens, pencils, and a calculator. Calculators for Physical Science and Biology must have square root, squaring, and scientific notation capabilities. Calculators for upper level courses must have log functions. Safety goggles are required for all courses and can be purchased for \$5 from the Science Department.

Social Studies - All classes require 3-ring binders with dividers and notebook paper, or a notebook, as well as blue/black pens.

Theology - 1" or 1.5" 3-ring binder. Bible-the New International Version or English Standard Version is preferred. All new students receive a new English Standard Bible.

Woods - Woods classes require #2 pencils and loose leaf lined paper or a pad of lined paper. Other items needed will be provided.

Student Pick Up After School

For brief windows of time, the ML parking lot/car line can have instances where cars are backed up onto 76th Street, waiting to pick up a student(s) in front of the building. This is an obviously unsafe circumstance for students and families. In an attempt to alleviate this concern, feel free to pick up your student in the parking lot at one of the doors along the north side of the building. Please make your student aware of this pick up location. If even a small number of parents choose this student pick up strategy, we would greatly minimize the risk of one or more of our families being struck while waiting on 76th Street. Thank you!

I hope that this information finds you and your family enjoying a fun and restful summer! The information in this letter will share the **UPDATED ATHLETIC REGISTRATION** process and **REQUIREMENTS** at Martin Luther High School for the 2018-2019 school year. All athletic registration is **REQUIRED** to be done online and all info can be found at www.martinlutherhathletics.org.

1. 2018-2019 Athletic Code Parent/Athlete Information Video and Verification Quiz
In an effort to respect your time, there will no longer be separate Fall, Winter or Spring
sports meetings at the beginning of each season. In place of these meetings, it will be a
registration requirement for a parent and student-athlete to watch the Video one time
per year. Following the viewing of the video, the parent and student-athlete will need
to complete a short 10 question video verification quiz, which will be a requirement to
be eligible to participate. The link to the video and quiz can be found under the "athletic
registration tab" at www.martinlutherathletics.org.

2. Online Registration - www.registermyathlete.com/login/

This new online registration service plans to be more user friendly for families and will allow a more streamlined approach. Find the link under the "athletic registration" tab at www.martinlutherathletics.org.

3. <u>Pay Athletic Fee</u> - \$75 per sport (Global Studies students already have this included in tuition)

You may pay online by credit card while registering at Register My Athlete (you will incur a small processing fee), or you may still pay by cash or check in the main office.

You may pay for all sports at once or pay per season.

1. Participation Physical/Alternate Form

Print **NEW** form from athletic website and complete. Be sure to check <u>"Students Not Needing Physicals for 2018-19"</u> document to see if your child needs a new physical or only needs the <u>Alternate year</u> completed.

*You can upload this form to your online registration at Register My Athlete or turn in directly to Ms. Monaghan in the main office.

Registration Opens July 16th! When all the registration requirements are met; Athletic Code Video Verification, online registration, athletic fee and participation physical/alternate form uploaded/turned in, the student-athlete can pick up their **Green Participation Card** in the main office beginning one week prior to the sport season start date.
