### Principal's Message Life Among the "Thems!"



Then Moses went out and spoke these words to all Israel: "I am now a hundred and twenty years old and I am no longer able to lead you. The LORD has said to me, 'You shall not cross the Jordan.' The LORD your God Himself will cross over ahead of you. He will destroy these nations before you, and you will take possession of their land. Joshua also will cross over ahead of you, as the LORD said. And the LORD will do to them what He did to Sihon and Og, the kings of the Amorites, whom He destroyed along with their land. The LORD will deliver them to you, and you must do to them all that I have commanded you. Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the LORD your God goes with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you."

Deuteronomy 31:1-6

The NBA, NFL, high school sports, mid-term elections, and competitions of all manner, variety, and sort, all have one thing in common; opponents. Every competition pits one side against another. Even if the event is scored by time and best performances against a clock, opposing times and those who earned them are still a part of competing. The Milwaukee Bucks handily beat the seemingly unbeatable, world champion Golden State Warriors last night! Against all odds, our young Bucks emerged victorious on the road! We beat them! Bet them real good, for that matter!

The Scripture passage from the book of Deuteronomy offered above can be looked at in this context of victory, opponents, and competition. Victory and delivery, not in terms of points, hoops, and scoreboards, but winning, survival, strength, and hope.

For our purposes, Moses can be described as the earthly "head coach" of the Children of Israel. Having been their leader for many years, he was addressing his "team" a final

time, preparing, challenging, and inspiring them prior to their next big battle and competition. Within this "pre-game" exhortation, what does he say?

Moses to the Israelites, "I am 120 years old and I have taken us as far as The Lord will allow." With that as the message, what does Moses tell these wanderers, "Go!" Go, because The Lord will destroy the nations and enemies that will oppose you. "And The Lord will do to them" what He did to other enemies. "He will deliver them to you, and you must do to them all that I have commanded to you." A clear mandate, don't you think?!

Then God through Moses moves on to the "whats and the what nots!" What? Be strong! What? Be courageous! There is no "them" at whose hand He will let His Children be destroyed. He has got us! What not? Afraid you ought not be because of "them!" Terrified is not who those who follow Him should ever be regardless of the "them!" The Lord destroyed all of the "thems" before Israel! "Them" have been defeated! "Them" no longer have the power! He does and will forever!

The "who" is those who follow The Lord! The "what" are His commands to hope and strength given to us in faith! And then there is the "why?" Why am I not afraid in the face of my enemies? Why am I not terrified as the "thems" close in around me? The Lord and His unending, non-negotiable, and all powerful love for me that's why! Why? "The Lord goes with me!" Why? "He will never leave me or forsake me!"



Encouraged and uplifted by our brothers and sisters in Christ. Go! I love that! Sometimes the road of my life is rough, unclear, daunting, and seemingly not survivable! "Hey Wayne, I am right here with you!" Hey Wayne, I am always going to be here! Go!"

Today and always, forgiven and redeemed, go boldly out into the world full of "thems" doing so alive in the supreme confidence that nothing and nobody can or ever will be able to defeat you and separate you from the eternal love of Jesus Christ and His Eternal Promise of Life and Salvation! Amen!
