Parents/Guardians:

We are rolling over your current student's donor-funded financial aid award from the 2018-19 school year to the 2019-20 school year. Therefore, you do not need to re-apply for

tuition assistance in TADS. Please note this commitment to roll over your student's financial aid is not taken lightly. We trust that if your financial situation has changed positively or negatively, you will contact us and engage in further conversation.

Your 2019-20 TADS billing account will be rolled over and will reflect the tuition for 2019-20 school year. Your donor-funded financial aid award will automatically apply to this billing account. If you receive the Association congregation discount and are still a member of good standing, this discount will also automatically apply to your billing account.
