****Students who are certified by one of our Partner (Association) congregations are eligible to receive the Partner Student Tuition rate. If certification is not obtained, or later withdrawn, the full tuition rate will be charged.*

A non-refundable Enrollment Fee of \$25 is required at the time of enrollment.

Other Fees:

Some specialized courses have an additional fee to cover the cost of consumable materials and supplies. These fees are listed in the 2019-2020 Course Catalog. Additional fees are also charged for individual instruction for instrumental or vocal music, field trips, and participation in sports programs.

Payment:

Martin Luther High School utilizes TADS, an online school tuition management system, and online payment processor. By May 1, 2019 or within 3 weeks of enrollment, you will receive an email containing a link to the TADS website to create a payment agreement. Your agreement/payment plan will include full tuition, less applicable credits, if any. The first tuition payment is due by June 15, 2019, and required in order to retain a class schedule. At least three monthly, one quarterly, or one semester payment must be made before school starts to allow your student to begin.

Withdrawal:

If a student withdraws, the family is obligated to pay all tuition and charges. The actual withdrawal date determines the amount of tuition refund, if any, based on the following schedule. A fee of \$250.00 will be assessed for all withdrawals.
