#### SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY:

Martin Luther students come from communities located mainly in Milwaukee County and southeastern Waukesha County. Forty-five percent of students are members of Lutheran congregations. Nine percent are Global Studies students from multiple countries.

Martin Luther High School, together with Milwaukee Lutheran and Lake Country Lutheran, is owned and operated by 31 Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod Congregations that form the Lutheran High School Association of Greater Milwaukee.

The school opened in 1968 and is located on 30 acres in the southwest Milwaukee suburb of Greendale. It continues the tradition of distinctive Lutheran Christian secondary education, which began in Milwaukee in 1903.

#### SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

**STUDENTS & FACULTY:** The student body of Martin Luther totals 524. We have 45 faculty and administration members. The average class size is 17 students. Student/teacher ratio is 13 to 1.

**CURRICULUM:** Students choose from over 100 course offerings in 14 departments.

Dual Credit Courses, in partnership with Concordia University-Nebraska, are offered in Physics, Spanish, and United States History. Forty-six students (2017-2018) received a total of 149 college credits from one or more dual-credit courses.

Advanced Placement Courses are offered in Art, Biology, Calculus, Computer Science, English Literature, Music Theory, Physics, Psychology, Statistics, United States History, and World History.

Accelerated Courses are available in English, Mathematics, Music, Science, Social Studies, and World Language.

**SPIRITUAL LIFE:** Chapel services, devotions and Spiritual Life activities provide opportunities for students to grow in their faith.

**CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:** We offer a rich fine arts program, student activity groups, and 20 seasonal sports teams. Martin Luther is a member of the Metro Classic Athletic Conference.
