



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the English language proficiency requirements?

There are no minimum requirements. Students with below grade equivalency language skills must attend Martin Luther High School where English development support is provided.

Students applying to Lake Country Lutheran must provide language test results that demonstrate grade equivalency skills.

Is there a specific English language proficiency test that is required?

No specific test is required. The TOEFL, ITEP, or the IELTS are all accepted tests.

Does your school accept international students in the Spring Semester?

Students are accepted before July 1st to begin the 1st semester of school year in mid-August. Students are accepted before November 1st to begin the 2nd semester of the school year in January. Students are encouraged to consider their career academic goals at an institution of higher learning beyond high school and achieving the necessary credits to receive a diploma from our school.

Does your school accept all grade levels?

Our schools accept students at all high school grade levels (9th – 12th). Priority acceptance is given to 9th and 10th graders. Students who want to attend the 12th grade year only must have high academic skills and be proficient in English language skills.

What are the living options that are available to students?

- Host Family recruited by the LHSAGM.
- Host Family recruited by the agent or student's family.
- Local Family that is connected to the student.
- New, on-campus dorm operated by the LHSAGM. Opens July 2020 for the 2020-2021 school year.

What is the cost for Tuition and Fees?

What is the cost for Living and Total Care provisions?

- On-campus dorm provided by the LHSAGM is \$9,025 per year or \$950 per month.
- Host Family provided by the LHSAGM will be an additional \$5,000 per year.
- Host Family provided by the agent is paid to the agent and set up 100% by the agent.
- A local family provided by the student's family is arranged by the family but must meet "safe zone" standards as determined by the LHSAGM.

Is there a separate Application Fee for students?

The application fee is \$250 that covers the cost of the student interview and the administrative costs to process the application.

Do you require an interview through SKYPE or WEChat?

Yes. The interview is arranged with Dr. Alvara. After the student submits their application form, an email will be sent to the student so the connection with the Dr. Alvara can be facilitated.
