



PROCEDURES FOR SEVERE WEATHER

Decisions regarding school cancellations and school campus closings are always made with the students' safety and best interests in mind. In the event of severe weather conditions, please tune your radio and/or TV to WISN Channel 12 for school closings.

Because weather conditions vary from one area to another, parents should use discretion in sending their son/daughter to school even though school may be in session. A general guideline to use in making the decision would be to follow the decision made by your local public school district.

Should a sudden snowstorm force school to close before the regular closing time, please make sure that your son/daughter knows exactly where to go and what to do should no one be home during the school day.

There may be some circumstances that necessitate the use of a "Digital Day" during which the campus is closed but school will be in session online for students through the school's learning management system Schoology. In those cases, the campus closing announcement in the school email alert and the Schoology announcement will include the accompanying notice of a "Digital Day" and students should subsequently login to Schoology for instructions from their teachers.
