#### FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

The first day of school is TUESDAY,

**AUGUST 21st** with the students attending:

9th- 8:00am to 3:00pm (lunch provided)

10th- 12:30pm to 2:00pm

11th- 10:30am to 12:00pm

12th- 8:30am to 10:30am

Students will go through orientation seminars regarding relationships and class unity, rules and guidelines, attendance, and specific areas that pertain to their class, etc.

Also, ID pictures (and yearbook pictures for underclassmen) will be taken of ALL students, so students should dress appropriately for photos (a head and shoulder shot will be taken). Therefore, the dress code is in effect this day.

We use a pre-pay program for school pictures so your payment must be turned in when pictures are taken or your receipt that pictures have been ordered online at <a href="https://www.vipis.com">www.vipis.com</a>.

#### SECOND DAY OF SCHOOL

Hall. Students will receive textbooks, course
outlines, etc. as well as information related to
goals and expectations for all their courses.

#### **SCHOOL SUPPLIES**

All new students will receive a free NIV Bible (sponsored by a donor) the first day of school that they will use for Bible class and LIFT.

Also, a calculator for mathematics class will be needed. We recommend a model no lower than TI-84+ graphing calculator (Texas Instrument) for all of our Math classes. Higher level calculators are certainly appropriate for all of our other level mathematics classes.

Finally, typical supplies of pencils, pens, three hole punched lined paper and appropriate three ringed binders, etc. will have your student prepared for the year. Teachers will provide a list of any specific materials needed for class the first day of school. Also, if you would like to take advantage of Back to School Sales, picking up 5 or 6-1" or 1 1/2" inch binders and 5 or 6 spiral notebooks is a great idea. Your student will probably organize their materials in them for a few of their classes.

#### **REQUIRED FOR ALL ATHLETES**

All LCL Athletes will need to turn in a Physical or Alternate Year form and complete Online Registration PRIOR TO their first practice.

- 1. Athletic Physical for most freshmen and juniors\* or Alternate Year Form- for most sophomores and seniors\* (\*Please note: an athletic physical is good for 2 school years so some sophomores and seniors may also need physicals depending on when last physical was done). You may upload the completed Physical Form on the Athletic Registration Website (see #2 below) or turn in to office. Alternate Year Form should be turned in to the office. Physicals will be offered at LCL for \$35 on July 27th and August 3rd. Our doctors donate their time and all money raised is used for athletic training supplies. Football players should sign up for the July 27th date to be ready for first practice. CLICK HERE to sign up for an appointment.

- 3. **Athletic Fees-** will be collected through your TADS Account once final rosters have been determined. Athletes are billed \$50 per Athletic Season with a maximum of \$100 per school year.
