Patient Discharge Plan—Nurse View

Patient Discharge Plan

Click on discharge from the Status Board 1 Discharge
Please note, this is a nursing view of the Discharge Plan, the provider will continue to have their view

2. Plan Disposition- Choose where the patient will be going upon discharge. This can be linked to forms that will automatically print at discharge
3. Assessments- Complete the patient discharge instructions
4. Forms- Patient forms. These can be individualized at a division or facility level
5. Discharge Order- The provider discharge order
6. Home Medication- If the provider has not completed the Home Medications, it can be finalized here. Please note, Print Packet will not work until this is complete
7. Vaccines- Vaccines given during the hospitalization. Will print with packet
8. Results- The A1C and glucose results will pull in & print with packet
9. Click on Finalize RX/ Orders
10. Click Submit & Refresh
11. Print Packet- Will print the entire packet. This will be given to the patient
12. Print Selection- Prints selected sections of the packet

Information from the discharge plan will be saved in the medical record. The signature page does not need to be signed, and can be thrown away.

Discharge Process Key Points

All discharges should be initiated by the Provider:

Discharge now, also known as “unconditional discharge”

- Provider order only process
- Provider note initiated with order process

Discharge Order with Parameter, previously known as “conditional discharge”

- “Parameter met/not met” process for provider and nursing
- The Provider cannot extend the order when discharge parameters are not met, the discharge parameter order must be cancelled and medical necessity for stay documented
- All conditional discharge order, discharge if order, pending discharge order must be retired/inactivated

Assumptions

- Medication reconciliation process is unaltered
- Provider and Nursing use discharge plan
- BHU Discharge process is out of scope
- Case Management systems not impacted



EBCD NUR Discharge Instructions Assessment Enhancements

- Vaccine programming updates (Covered in a Vaccine Training)
- Integration of the Discharge Parameters Intervention
- Sharing of key discharge elements with provider documentation and order entry
- Content updates for caregiver
- 5 consulting provider fields
- Pediatric Asthma Plan Updates
- Chest Pain Certification Documentation
- Transition Record field
