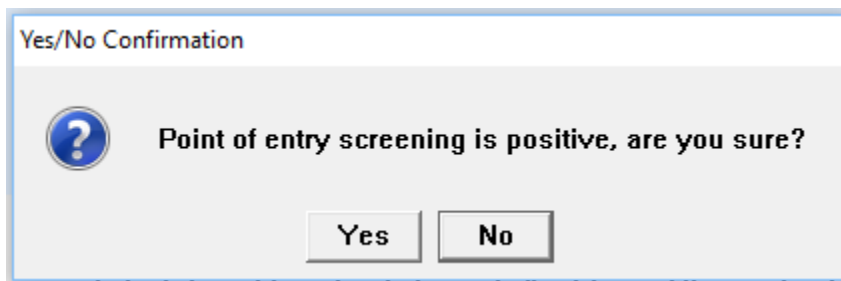

1ST point of contact screening (reverse highlight Magenta) icon indicates a positive TB and/or RESP screening and the user answered "Yes" to the mask application question.

1ST point of contact screening (reverse highlight Gray) icon indicates a positive TB and/or RESP screening and that a mask was not placed on patient. The end user will receive the below warning if they click "No" to the mask application question.



The end user will then have to click No again.

If no 1st point of contact icon is present, it indicates Negative TB and/or RESP screening and the query for the mask placement is skipped.

TA (reverse highlight Red) icon indicates that the query “Have you or someone you are close to traveled outside the US in the past three weeks” was answered with a “Yes.”

TA (reverse highlight GRAY) icon indicates that the query “Have you or someone you are close to traveled outside the US in the past three weeks” was answered with a “No.”

If there is no TA icon present on the tracker, it indicates the first point of contact screening was not completed.
