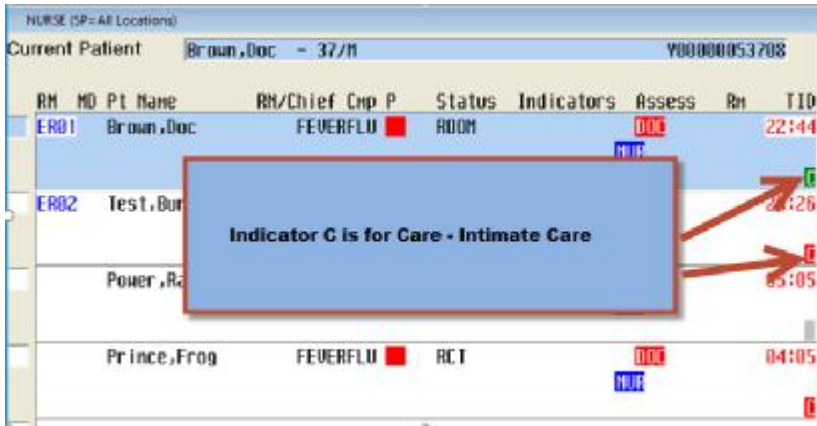

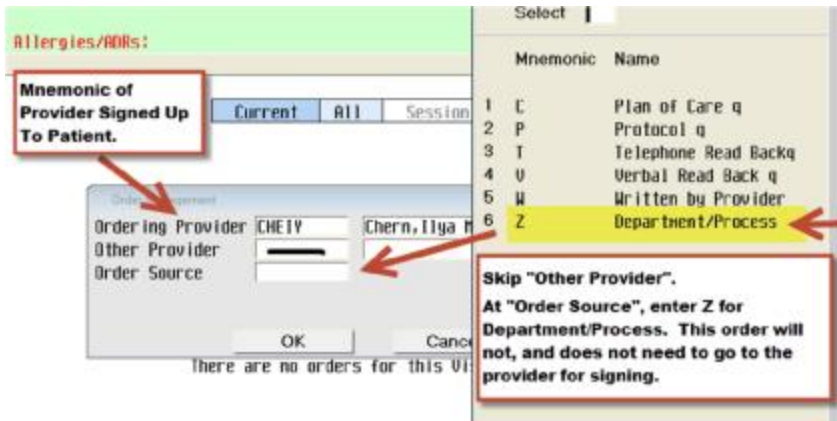

New **Intimate Care** -“C” Indicator will appear on:

1. Standardized Nurse Private Tracker
2. Standardized My List Nurse Private Tracker

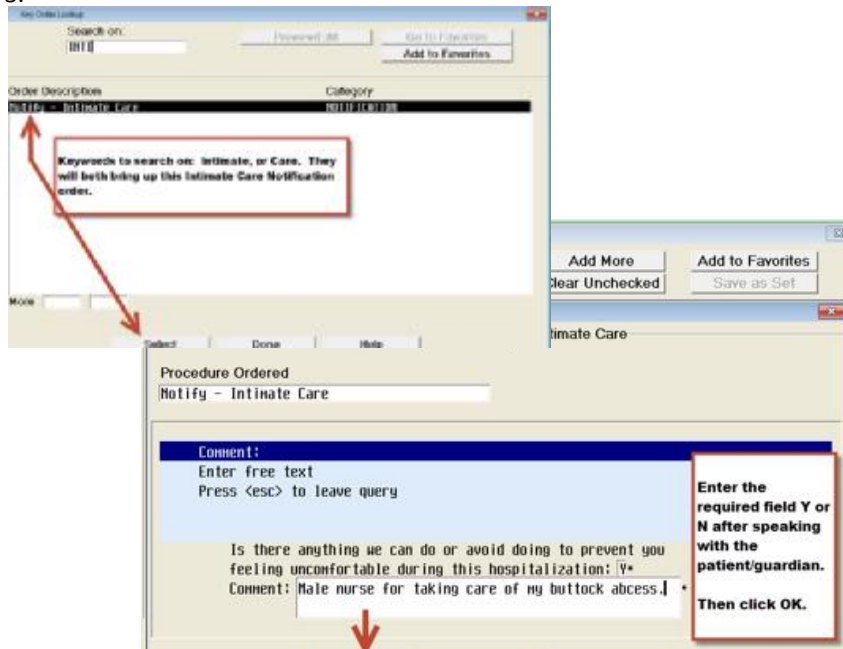

Steps to enter the Notify– Intimate Care Order:

1. From EDM Private Tracker, click on the “Orders” button
2. Click on “Orders” button again from the **Review Patient Orders** screen
3. Enter mnemonic of provider who is signed up for the patient as the “Ordering Provider”, skip “Other Provider”, and use “Z Department/Process” as “Order Source”.
4. Select the “Intimate Care Notification Order”
5. Ask the patient the intimate care question on the screen and then document “Y” or “N”, as it is required. If “Y”, enter the patient’s response in the **Comment** box.
6. Click **OK** and **Submit** the order.
