

OB Documentation Less than 39 Weeks Screen

Overview of Changes

- A new OE screen has been developed that aids in the documentation of OB Inductions in patients between 37 and 39 weeks gestation in order to meet the [PC-01 measure](#) associated with this process.
- OE was chosen as the location for this screen due to the ability to reflex off the new Level of Care Admission order as well as the ability to utilize screen logic to present providers a succinct, usable screen.

Level of Care: (Or FreeTxt)	
1 Behavioral Health	5 Acute Inpatient Rehab
2 Critical Care	6 Skilled Nursing
3 General Medicine/Surgery	7 Step down
4 Obstetrics	8 Telenetry

The order can be attached to reflex off the Admission **Level of Care** Order

The provider is then prompted to answer questions regarding the admission. The yellow box displays any available nursing documentation:

- 1) Multiple Gestation?
 - Yes – order can be filed
 - No – moves to second question
- 2) 37-39 weeks EGA Admission?
 - No – order can be filed
 - Yes – moves to next screen
