Rounding Nurse (RN):

The Rounding Nurse (RN) must have equivalent qualifications, competence and function in the same role as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility, as defined by facility job description.

Definition of Care or Service:

The Rounding Nurse (RN) assists the physician with daily hospital rounds. Scope of Service may include:

- Observes and reports clinical findings to the supervising physician
 - Documents these findings in the medical record
- Provides patient and family education
- Complies with hospital and medical staff policy and procedures for accepting and documenting telephone orders from the supervising physician
 - o Complies with hospital and medical staff policy and procedure specific to:
 - i. Restraints
 - ii. Do Not Resuscitate (DNR)
 - iii. High Alert Medications (Including chemotherapy)
 - iv. Investigational Drugs
- Rounding Nurse medical record entries will not be accepted for physician designated responsibilities such as but not limited to: physician rounds, history and physical or discharge summary
- Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include code of HCA conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians.

Setting(s):

- Healthcare facilities including but not limited to hospitals, outpatient treatment facilities, imaging centers, and physician practices
- Patient care areas, all settings

Supervision:

- Direct supervision by at least one member of the medical staff with active staff privileges
 - Indirect supervision by the nursing department director or designee

Evaluator: Supervising physician, medical staff member in conjunction with the nursing department director or designee

Tier Level: 2

eSAF Access Required: YES

Qualifications:

- Associates degree or higher
- Valid licensed as a RN

NOTE: Where education may not be defined in qualifications area of the Scope, HCA requires the highest level of education completed (not training or courses) confirmed on your background check.

State Requirements:

Currently licensed as an RN in the State of Texas



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Experience:

• At least one year as a RN

Competencies:

The Rounding Nurse (RN) will demonstrate:

- A safe environment for patients
 - Uses at least two ways to identify patients before assessing, treating or performing a procedure
 - Participates in the pre-procedure process to verify the correct procedure, for the correct patient, at the correct site and involves the patient in the verification process when possible
- Accurate patient information review and evaluation
 - o Collects and documents observation data in the medical record.
 - Entries in the medical record are countersigned by the attending physician within 24 hours
 - o Facilitates communication between the physician, patient, family and nursing staff
 - o Educates patients and their family about the medical treatment plan and discharge plans
 - Notifies the appropriate member of the interdisciplinary patient care team of issues that require immediate intervention or attention
- Infection Prevention
 - o Practices consistent hand hygiene
 - o Uses personal protective equipment (PPE) when required
 - o Required immunizations per Division requirements
 - Complies with Isolation precaution
