<p>Clinical Technician: The Clinical Technician must have equivalent qualifications, competence and function in the same role as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility, as defined by facility job description.</p> <p>Definition of Care or Service: The Clinical Technician provides patient care through minimally invasive support services and other patient care services for surgical procedures and such care may include, but is not limited to performance of the duties and responsibilities listed below. This position acts as a resourced person for the agency’s customers and associates. Acts as an assistant to a nurse and/or surgeon during a surgical procedure. Scope of Service may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Independently manages laparoscopic procedures which include all tower functions, pre-operative set up, knowledge and application of instrumentation at facility. • Demonstrates knowledge and application of instrumentation at facility, trouble shooting and technical support during procedures. • Reads, understands, and implements all policies and procedure guidelines. Collects and reports quality improvement data as requested. • Collects and reports quality indicator data as requested. Demonstrates quality improvement. • Ensures that all required documentation is done according to protocol established by the facility, Agency and/or region. • Notifies appropriate person(s)/department(s) when problems develop with equipment and/or personnel. • Cleans equipment at the end of each case, prepares equipment for next case and appropriately disposes of all refuse. • Informs appropriate individuals of inventory level, equipment condition, and general needs. • Assists physician and other clinical staff members as requested. • Ensures that supplies are ordered, stocked and available as needed. • Establishes and maintains procedures to communicate and document potential or real equipment problems to all members of the clinical team. • May participate in appropriate hospital committees for demonstration of quality (e.g. blood management and process/outcome improvement). Present data to these committees and the surgeons on at least a quarterly basis. • Performs other duties and works on special projects as assigned. • Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include code of HCA conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians.

Competencies: The Clinical Technician will demonstrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides a safe environment for patients <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Uses at least two ways to identify patients before treating or performing a procedure ○ Labels containers used for blood and specimens in the presence of the patient ○ Labels all medications and solutions on and off the sterile field in perioperative and procedural settings ○ Participates in the pre-procedure process to verify the correct procedure, for the correct patient, at the correct site and involves the patient in the verification process when possible ○ Participates in a time-out immediately before starting an invasive procedure or making the incision ○ Participates in appropriate surgical counts with the circulator prior to the operation and before incision is closed as per hospital policy • Basic aseptic technique <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Applies sterile attire including scrubbing, gowning and gloving ○ Uses sterile technique for scrubbing, gowning and gloving of other personnel ○ Organizes sterile drapes ○ Receives sterile equipment via circulating nurse using sterile technique ○ Assists with patient dressing application • Effective communication and interpersonal skills <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Coordinates case preparation ○ Transfers sterile instruments to surgeon accurately ○ Anticipates surgeon needs ○ Assists with care of instruments at end of case ○ Demonstrates working knowledge of anatomy and physiology • Infection Prevention <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Practices consistent hand hygiene ○ Uses personal protective equipment (PPE) ○ Required immunizations per Division requirements ○ Complies with Isolation precautions
