<b>Division: GULF COAST</b>
<b>Classification: WOUND CARE (RN)</b>
<b>Applicant Name:</b>
<p><b>Wound Care (RN):</b> The Wound Care (RN) must have equivalent qualifications and competence as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility.</p>
<p><b>Definition of Care or Service:</b> The Wound Care (RN) cares for patients with wounds caused by medical treatments, diseases, or injuries. Scope of Service may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Performs nursing evaluation upon initial visit for all appropriate patients</li> <li>• Performs and documents comprehensive wound care assessment on each visit</li> <li>• Documents all nursing interventions, nursing, care, medications given, pertinent finding, complications and any other medical information of nursing related care on all patients</li> <li>• Performs and documents vital signs on each visit</li> <li>• Perform glucose monitoring and documentation on all diabetic patients</li> <li>• The RN is responsible for all drugs used in the department whether they are kept in the department or in the pharmacy</li> <li>• Carries out all orders given by physicians that fall within the scope of nursing practice</li> <li>• Transports patients as needed</li> <li>• Educates the patients and their families on wound care procedures and dressing changes</li> <li>• Provides care for pediatric, adolescent, adult and geriatric patients</li> <li>• Performs all other duties as assigned by the supervisor</li> <li>• Interventions provided by the RN include by are not limited to the following: wound vacs, two-layer wraps, casts, and skin substitutions.</li> <li>• Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include HCA Healthcare code of conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians</li> </ul>
<p><b>Setting:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Outpatient wound care and hyperbaric clinic</li> </ul>

<p><b>Qualifications:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Associates degree or higher in Nursing</li> <li>• RN Licensure</li> <li>• American Heart Association or Red Cross health care provider BLS Certification</li> </ul>

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**NOTE:** Where education may not be defined in qualifications area of the Scope, HCA Healthcare requires the highest level of education completed (not training or courses) confirmed on your background check.

**State Requirements:**

- Current RN license for Texas or Compact license

**Experience:**

- Two to three years' experience as a RN in Wound Care

**Competencies:**

The Wound Care (RN) will demonstrate:

- A safe environment for patients
  - Uses at least two ways to identify patients before assessing and treating
  - Participates in the pre-procedure process to verify the correct procedure, for the correct patient, at the correct site and involves the patient in the verification process when possible
- Accurate patient information review and evaluation
  - Collects and documents assessment data in the medical record
    - Entries in the medical record are countersigned by the attending physician within 24 hours
  - Facilitates communication between the physician, patient, family and nursing staff
  - Educates patients and their family about the medical treatment plan and discharge plans
  - Notifies the appropriate member of the interdisciplinary patient care team of issues that require immediate intervention or attention
- Infection Prevention
  - Practices consistent hand hygiene
  - Uses personal protective equipment (PPE) when required
  - Required immunizations per Division requirements
  - Complies with Isolation precautions
