Educator (Generalist) :

The Educator (Generalist) must have equivalent qualifications, competence and function in the same role as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility.

Definition of Care or Service:

The Educator (Generalist) will provide clinical leadership, education and support. Focus will be on continual education, introduction to new practices, growth and continuous improvement in practices and patient outcomes. Scope of service may include:

- Applies learning and teaching principles in the design of a course, unit, module or subject area
- Gathers and interprets basic information on the needs of learners
- Appropriately uses a broad range of educational methods and technologies to achieve intended learning outcomes
- Describes ways of involving learners in actual clinical practice (e.g. experiential learning opportunities)
- Uses a broad range of methods to assess learners
- Interprets and applies the results of educational research to their educational practice
- Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include HCA Healthcare code of conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians

- Ability to provide direction and control to individuals as well as multiple teams
- Ability to effectively manage multiple priorities and multi-level tasks.
- Ability to analyze information and use logic and process to address work-related issues and problems
- Working knowledge of HIPAA privacy and security rules
- Application of health care data analysis to improve health care processes as necessary.

 - Practices consistent hand hygiene
 - Uses personal protective equipment (PPE)
 - Required immunizations per Division requirements
 - Complies with Isolation precautions
