<p>Clinical Nurse Manager: The Clinical Nurse Manager must have the equivalent qualifications and competencies as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility.</p>
<p>Definition of Care or Service: The Clinical Nurse Manager works with facility clinical staff to provide clinical re-assessment information, provide patient care in hospital patient care settings. Facilitates and advocates for options and services to meet an individual’s health needs. Services are limited to those patients who are residents or patients from the Clinical Nurse Manager’s employed facility or organization. Scope of Service may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Providing patient home medication list with dosages. • Provide patient health history and provide awareness to hospital staff regarding patient’s other psychological and physiological challenges. • Communicating patient diet restrictions and preferences. • Provide observation, re-assessment, intervention, rehabilitation, care and counsel, and health teachings to the patient. • Provides input on nursing care plan. • Communicates with available resources to promote quality cost-effective outcomes. • Work to achieve discharge back to prior facility residence. • Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include the HCA code of conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians • Maintains confidentiality and privacy with HIPAA regulations. • Services are defined by any limitation in practice that may be addressed by state law.
