As a patient safety and health care personnel safety initiative, Methodist Healthcare System is requiring vaccinations for the following vaccine-preventable diseases. This is similar to other vaccinations that Methodist Healthcare System requires as a condition of employment. Certain vaccinations have been recommended by the Centers for Disease Control for health care personnel and have been shown to be effective in protecting patients from these illnesses and complications related to them. Increasingly, national professional, health care and infection prevention organizations are recommending that health care organizations require certain vaccinations to protect the health and safety of patients, employees, patient and employee family members, and the community as a whole from these diseases.
