Definition of Care or Service:

The Neonatal Photographer provides photography services to newborns and families.

Scope of Service may include:

- Discusses photography options with mother/family
- Photographs newborn per mother/family request and facility policy
- Maintains a safe newborn environment by being knowledgeable of fall and injury prevention, and infection control measures
- Notifies the RN immediately of an emergency or sudden change in newborn condition
- Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include code of HCA Healthcare conduct corefundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians

 - Maintains equipment in good working order



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- o Demonstrates effective infection control practices related to equipment and supplies
- Effective communication and interpersonal skills
 - o Demonstrates tactful, understanding, and dependable behaviors
 - Communicate effectively with infant and mother/family
 - o Communicates sudden changes in patient status to the primary nurse immediately
- Provides appropriate and safe infant photograph positioning per mother/family request

 - Practices consistent hand hygiene
 - Uses personal protective equipment (PPE) when required
 - Required immunizations per Division requirements
 - Complies with Isolation precautions
 - Maintains sterile field
