

Maintenance Guidelines

SpaGuard Spa Complete

FRESH FILL (start-up)

- 1. Check and balance total alkalinity (125-150ppm)
 - Adjust as needed with SpaGuard Total Alkalinity Increaser or SpaGuard pH Decreaser.
- 2. Check and balance pH (7.4-7.6)
 - Adjust as need with SpaGuard pH Increaser or SpaGuard pH Decreaser.
- 3. Check and balance Calcium Hardness levels (100-200ppm)
 - Adjust as needed with SpaGuard Calcium Hardness Increaser or Vanishing Act Calcium Remover (if Calcium hardness is less than 100ppm DO NOT USE Vanishing Act).
- 4. Establish chlorine residual (3-5ppm) with **SpaGuard Chlorine Concentrate**.
- 5. Add 1 capful of SpaGuard Spa Complete per 100 gallons of spa water at low-speed circulation.
- 6. You can use the tub 15 minutes after this is applied to the water.

AFTER EACH USE

1. Add 1 capful of SpaGuard Spa Shock to the water after every use. If using the spa every night, do 3x a week. It is recommended to test and adjust free chlorine at 3-5ppms with SpaGuard Chlorine Concentrate.

WEEKLY

- 1. Add ½ capful SpaGuard Spa Complete per 250 gallons of spa water at low-speed circulation.
- 2. You can use the tub 15 minutes after this is applied to the water.

REGULAR MAINTENANCE

- 1. Every 30 Days: Bring in your water to any Georgia Spa location and get your water tested to check all your levels.
- 2. Rinse filter w/ SpaGuard Filter Cleaner every 4 weeks.
- 3. Soak filter thoroughly with **SpaGuard Filter Cleaner** every 2-3 months.
- 4. Vacation: reduce temperature by 20% and add your normal chemical dosage on the day you leave.

MEASUREMENT KEY

3 teaspoons = 1 tablespoon

1 tablespoon = 0.5 ounce

8 ounces = 1 cup
