Swim Spa Start Up & Maintenance Guidelines

Endless Pools FreshWater Silver Ion System

Water Care 101: Changes to your swim spa's water chemistry are normal and can happen rapidly based on many factors including usage, water temperature, and water level. Regular testing and adjustments are recommended for a fun and safe swim spa ownership experience. The following guide outlines our recommended steps that you should take to maintain your swim spa's water care. *Don't worry, you'll be a pro in no time!*

Have These Items Ready:

- Test Strips
- Mineral Cartridges (Every 4 Months)
 - *Up to 5 depending on model swim spa.
 - 2x - R200, R220, R500, X200
 - 4x - X500, E500, E550, E700
 - 5x - X2000, E2000



*****Administer chemicals while the jets are ON, run for 10 minutes and turn OFF*****

FRESH FILL (Start Up)

Follow these steps during initial filling or refilling after draining.

1. Fill swim spa with water (use a **Pre-Filter** during the fill cycle for well water). First, remove filter and filter lid/basket. Add water directly to swim spa through the filter compartment. Fill to above all jets and just below pillows/headrests (if applicable).
2. After filling, replace filter components and follow the instructions provided in your owner's manual to turn on your swim spa and begin heating (if desired).



3. Add **SpaGuard Stain & Scale Control** (1 oz. per 100 gallons)

Ideal Range: Adjust with:

4. Check and balance total alkalinity. 80-120 ppm **SpaGuard Total Alkalinity Increaser**
SpaGuard pH Decreaser
5. Check and balance pH. 7.2-7.6 ppm **SpaGuard pH Increaser or pH Decreaser**
6. Check calcium hardness. Up to 150 ppm **SpaGuard Calcium Hardness Increaser**
IF over 150 ppm, contact Georgia Spa before adjusting. (not included in start-up kit)
7. Super-chlorinate the spa by adding 1 tbsp. of **SpaGuard Chlorinating Concentrate** per 500 gallons.
8. Place **Silver Ion Cartridges** (1 per 500 gallons) into the filter skimmer tray(s) per instructions.
NOTE: Do NOT exceed 2 cartridges per tray.

*****Leave cover open for a minimum of 20 minutes for off-gassing to prevent damage to cover and pillows*****

*****Pro Tip: Maintenance frequency may vary based on usage*****

MEASUREMENT KEY:

3 teaspoons = 1 tablespoon

1 tablespoon = 0.5 ounces

8 ounces = 1 cup

WEEKLY SPA CARE:

1. Regularly test water for **pH**, **total alkalinity** and **calcium** levels (refer to steps 4-6 of the Fresh Fill instructions).
2. Maintain correct chlorine (1-3 ppm).
3. Add 2 tbsp. of **SpaGuard Spa Shock** per 300 gallons to prevent the buildup of contaminants, maximize chlorine efficiency, minimize combined chlorine, and improve water clarity (recommended weekly, or after each use).



*****Pro Tip: Do not use Tri-Chlor Chlorine products in your Endless Pool*****

EVERY 30 DAYS:

1. Add 1 tbsp. of **SpaGuard Chlorinating Concentrate** per 500 gallons to perform a super-chlorination treatment (recommended at least monthly).
2. Check your filters. If they are dirty, use **SpaGuard Filter Cleaner** to clean (recommended at least every 4-8 weeks).

*Best results are achieved when filters are soaked in filter cleaner overnight (make sure to rinse filters before placing back into spa). Dirty filters may cause cloudy water, low jet pressure or FLO errors in fitness machine.

PRO TIP: Having an extra set of filters to rotate at cleaning helps speed up this process.

FREE Water Testing! Bring us a sample of your swim spa water, and we'll test it and provide a report of steps to take to adjust your spa water. Showrooms open Monday-Saturday, 10 a.m. - 7 p.m., and Sunday 1-5 p.m.
We recommend having your water tested every 30 days.



EVERY 4 MONTHS (As Needed):

1. Draining and refilling your swim spa will be based on many details. Typically, every 4-6 months you will want to do a partial drain. Call us if you have questions.
2. The **Silver Ion Cartridges** MUST be replaced every 4 months. Even though the cartridge might sound full after 4 months, the active ingredient inside has been exhausted.

PRO TIP: Sign up for our **Home Auto Ship** Program and when your shipment arrives it's the reminder you'll need to change the Mineral Cartridge.

*****Pro Tip: Call GSC's service department to schedule a UV-C bulb replacement annually*****
