

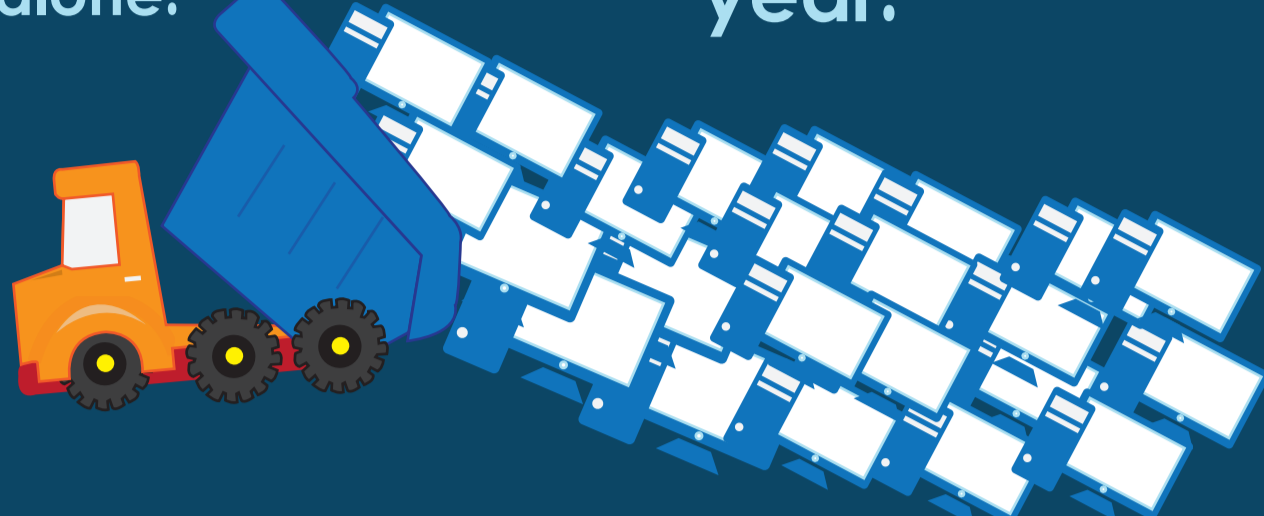

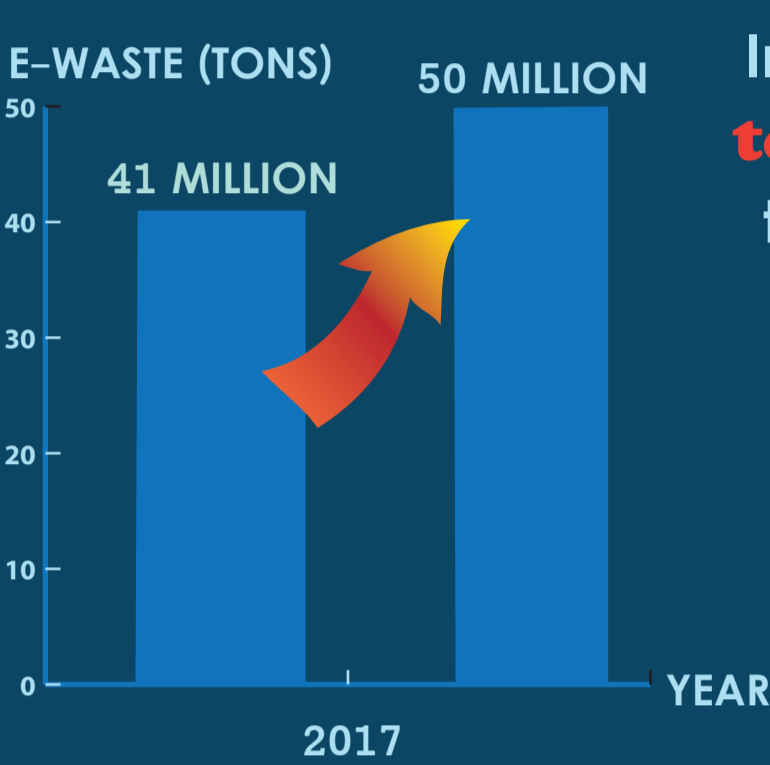
RECYCLING EXCESS IT EQUIPMENT HELPS PRESERVE THE ENVIRONMENT

Over **112,000** computers are discarded every single day, in the U.S. alone.

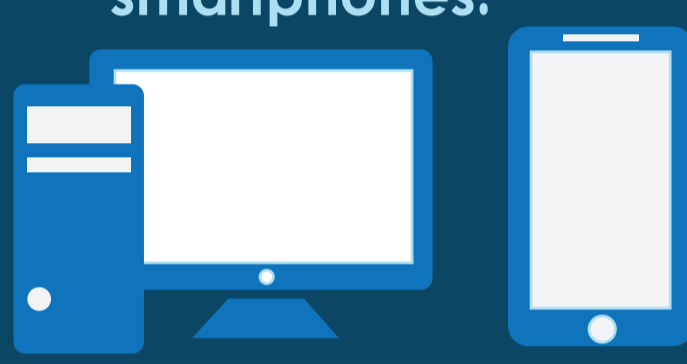
20 million TVs are trashed in the U.S. every year.



FACT: Computers' parts such as LCD screens or circuit boards can be recycled and reused in other computerized devices.

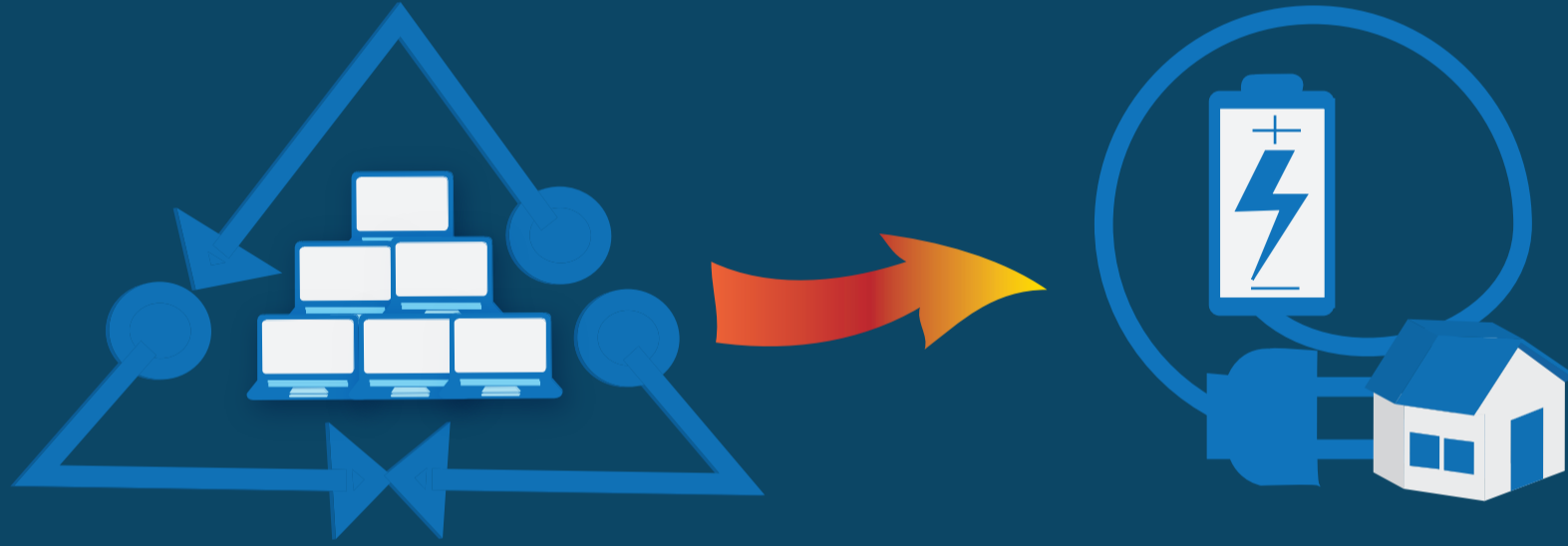


In 2017, about **50 million tons** of e-waste is expected to be dumped in landfills – mainly computers and smartphones.

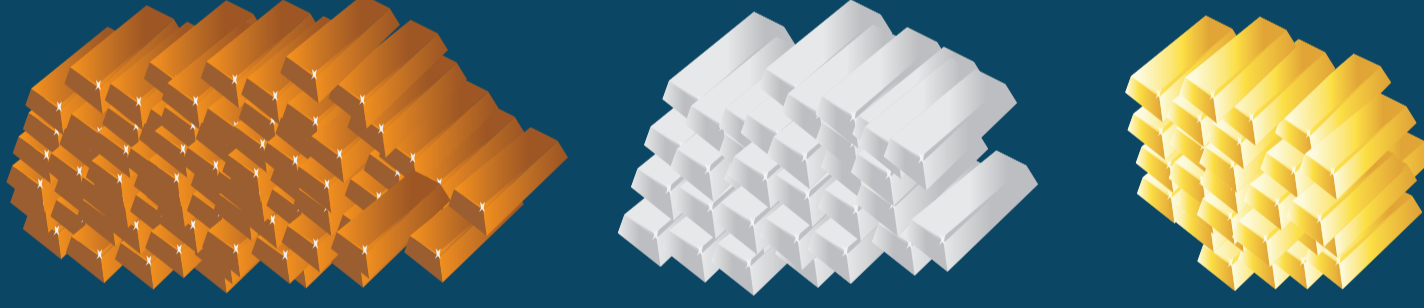


RECYCLING EXCESS IT EQUIPMENT CONTRIBUTES TO CONSERVING NATURAL RESOURCES

The Environmental Protection Agency reports that recycling one million laptops saves the energy equivalent to the electricity used by more than **3,500** U.S. homes in a year.

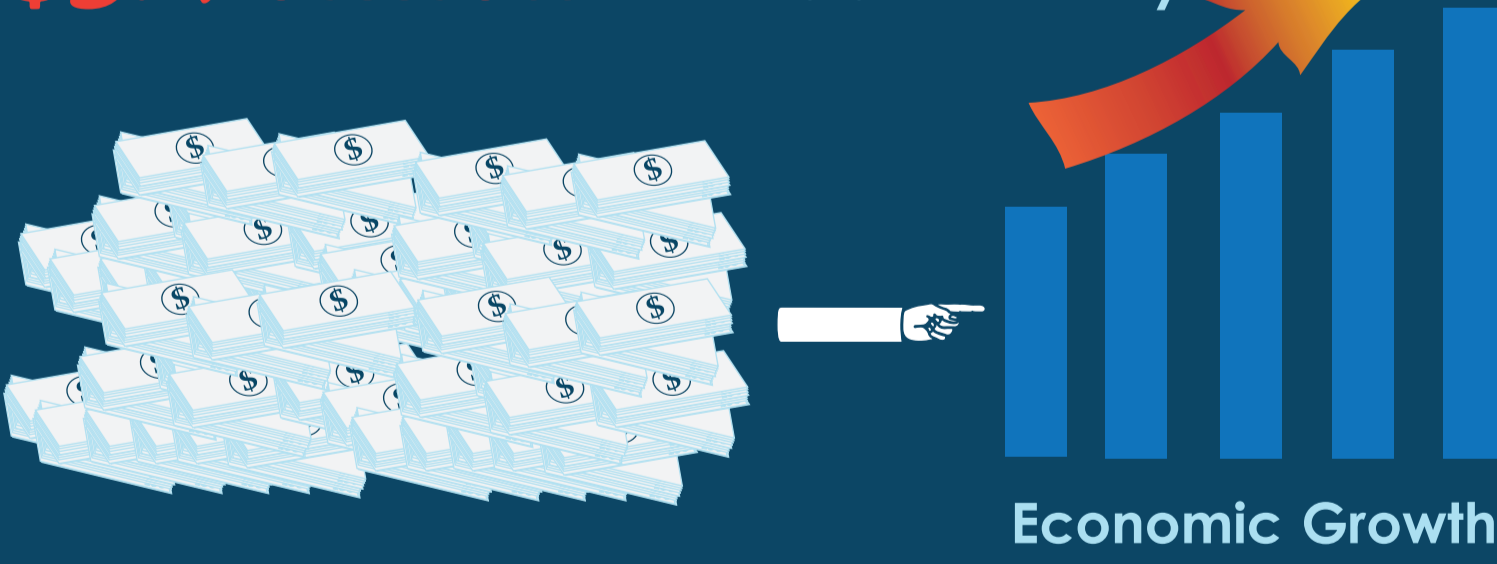


For every million cell phones the U.S recycled, **35,000** pounds of copper, **772** pounds of silver, and **75** pounds of gold can be recovered.

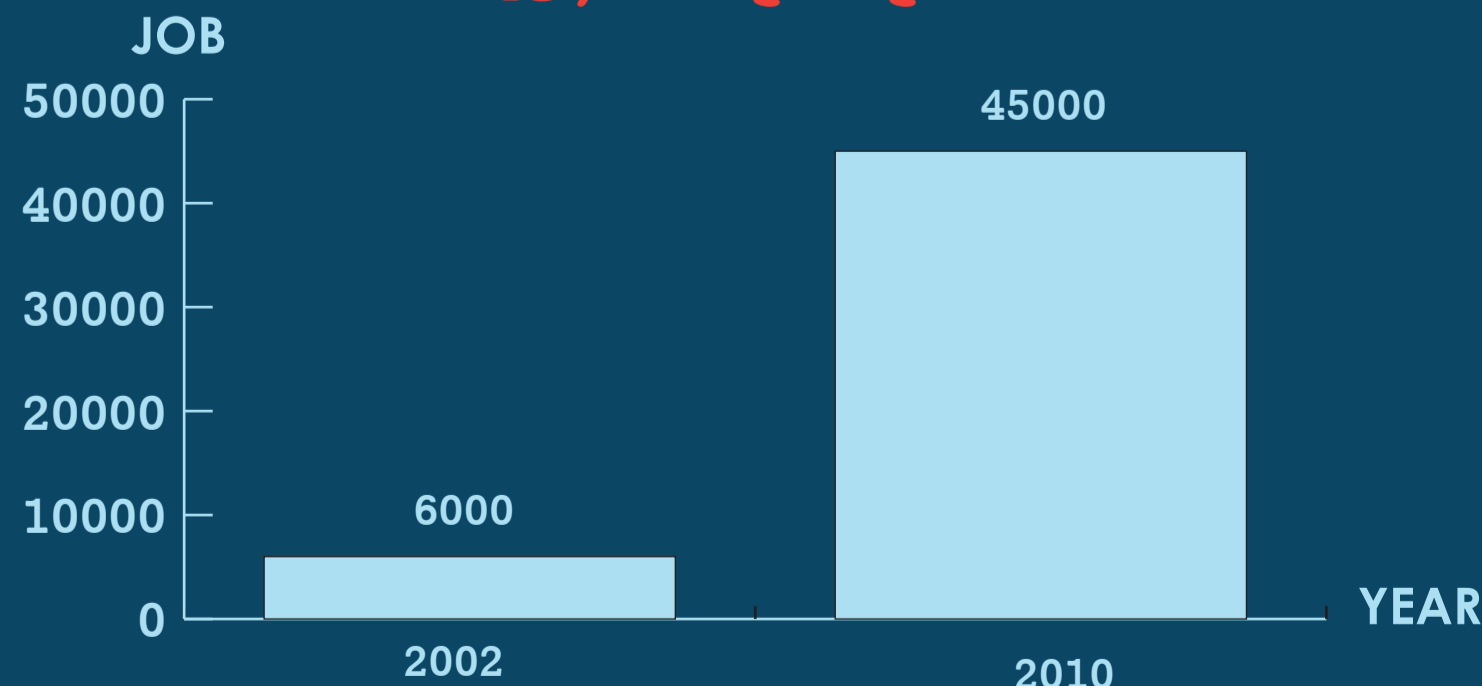


THE E-WASTE RECYCLING INDUSTRY LEADS TO JOB GROWTH

In 2010, the recycling industry contributed **\$5.2 billion** to the U.S. economy.



In 2002, the recycling industry employed **6,000 people**, by 2010 the industry employed **45,000 people**.
