

# Conquer CAEP with GoReact Video

Recording student teaching gives you evidence to meet CAEP standards—but recording with GoReact makes it even easier.

## **CAEP Standard 1**

### **Content and Pedagogical Knowledge**

Use video recordings as evidence that students achieve the correct teaching standards. With GoReact, you can build customized rubrics and markers to organize and identify specific InTASC, SPA, NBPTS, or NASM standards.

## **CAEP Standard 2**

### **Clinical Partnerships and Practice**

Supervisors use GoReact's rubrics and markers to communicate feedback directly on videos. This encourages inter-rater reliability, consistency, and effective coaching. Because all GoReact videos are stored in the cloud, this helps programs overcome any time or location differences between partners.

## **CAEP Standard 3**

### **Candidate Quality, Recruitment, & Selectivity**

GoReact's cloud-based software can store hundreds of hours of video for each preservice teacher. Show student growth by compiling application videos, student teaching videos, and videos of student teaching candidates answering questions, discussing the profession, reviewing codes of ethics, etc.

**Tip:** Have program applicants upload video applications into GoReact. Include a rubric to ensure a consistent review process.

## **CAEP Standard 4**

### **Program Impact**

To show your program is making a difference, have program completers record themselves teaching one year after graduation. The GoReact software stores video submissions for a minimum of five years, so it's simple for students and programs to retain data after graduation.
