

SCRIPT-VX-2 Description

Hello, I'm Sam Say with SSCOR and I am speaking about an aspirator that fulfills your need for both an onboard and a portable aspirator.

The VX2 is a full featured aspirator that can be mounted in the action area of an ambulance. In this position the VX2 is essentially an onboard vacuum system. It has a regulator and a gauge and is activated by its on/off switch.

It is as powerful as any onboard vacuum system and can be regulated to any vacuum level between less than 50 mmHg negative pressure and greater than 525 mmHg.

With one hand the VX2 can be removed and taken to the patient's side. Now it is a portable aspirator that is very powerful, fully adjustable, rugged and light weight at less than ten pounds.

As a portable and onboard aspirator, the VX2 can fulfill both functions for your ambulance crew. If you typically respond to the patient with a dedicated portable suction, or a manual suction, the VX2 can serve as your onboard and as a backup outside the vehicle for particularly challenging cases, multiple patients or other extraordinary cases. In short, it is an onboard suction that is not 'chained' to the vehicle.

VX2 features include –

A protective canister bracket

A fully adjustable regulator and gauge that provides any vacuum level between less than 50 mmHg and greater than 525 mmHg in less than a quarter turn of the knob.

Battery condition indicator

Running light

Active connection light, letting you know that the device is connected to vehicle power.

Tubing strap to hold patient tubing and suction tips.

The VX2 is versatile, fulfilling your requirements for both portable and onboard suction.
