We are pleased your child's school is working with Diamond Mind to enable online tuition payments. We hope this information answers questions you may have about our role and helps you get started with the online tuition payment process.

WHO IS DIAMOND MIND?

IF I HAVE A QUESTION ABOUT A PAYMENT, DO I CALL MY SCHOOL OR DIAMOND MIND?

Diamond Mind provides a method for your payment and processes that payment, but it does not oversee the management of student accounts. Your school is still the main contact for billing questions. You will have access to your tuition payment history online, but if a question remains, it's recommended that your first point of contact be your school's business office.

WHAT IS A PAYMENT SERVICE PROVIDER AND WHY DOES MY SCHOOL USE ONE?

When payments are accepted electronically, a service provider is required. Every school that accepts electronic payments and credit cards needs a provider, whether that is a bank or a vendor such as PayPal. Your school has chosen Diamond Mind, in part, because we work exclusively with independent schools. We simplify the acceptance, processing, and reconciling of payments.

ARE YOU LIKE FACTS?

Not really. Diamond Mind is not a tuition management company. Management companies are contracted by schools to outsource all aspects of tuition acceptance: billing, payment plans, payment acceptance and, if necessary, collection. Diamond Mind enables schools to maintain control over these steps so that schools can provide payment flexibility, receive payments directly, and maintain a closer family/school relationship.

IS MY ONLINE PAYMENT SECURE?


Yes! Diamond Mind is certified to be fully PCI (Payment Card Industry) compliant and adheres to the highest payment card industry data security standard.
