



From June 27th to July 6th, 2016, the tennis world will descend upon the historic All England Lawn Tennis Club, where since 1877 many of the sport's greatest competitors have tested their skill and determination on Wimbledon's infamous natural grass courts.

Arguably the most impressive and prestigious Major Tennis Tournaments, the early rounds of Singles and Doubles are played during the first week, with top seeds playing on the Centre Court and Courts 1 and 2. The Ladies' and Men's Singles Finals take place over the final weekend of the Championships. Each year five major events are contested, as well as four junior events and three invitational events. The five major trophies which the players compete for during the course of the Wimbledon Championships include:

- Gentlemen's Singles Trophy first presented by the All England Club in 1887. It replaced the Field Cup (1877-1883) and the Challenge Cup (1884-1886) which were both won by William Renshaw after twice winning the gentlemen's title three times in succession.
- The Ladies' Singles Trophy is a silver salver, sometimes referred to as the Rosewater Dish or Venus Rosewater Dish, which was first presented to the Champion when the challenge round was introduced in 1886.
- The Gentlemen's Doubles Trophy is a silver challenge cup for the Gentlemen's Pairs' competition. When the doubles moved to Wimbledon in 1884 the Oxford University Lawn Tennis Club presented the trophy to the All England Club.
- The Ladies' Doubles Trophy is an elegant silver cup and cover, known as The Duchess of Kent Challenge Cup, presented to the Club in 1949 by HRH The Princess Marina, President of the All England Club.
- The Mixed Doubles Trophy is a silver challenge cup and cover presented to the All England Club by the family of the late S.H. Smith. S.H. Smith won the doubles title in 1902 and 1906, in partnership with the late F.L. Riseley.





Below is a brief summary of the spectator information you should know before heading to Wimbledon. For further information we recommend you visit www.wimbledon.com.

Entry to the Grounds of the All England Lawn and Tennis Club requires a valid ticket that must be retained at all times and implies acceptance of the following conditions which have been established for the safety and enjoyment of all visitors, and may be amended at anytime:

The All England Lawn Tennis Club (Championships) Limited ("AELTC") reserves the right to limit items which may be brought into the Grounds and to search bags, vehicles and the person before granting entry to the Grounds and other specific facilities within the Grounds.

The following items are prohibited from the Grounds:

- Any bag exceeding 16" x 12" x 12"
- Hard-sided items of any size
- Any item which may be interpreted as a potential weapon, including sharp or pointed objects and 'personal protection' sprays
- Large flags (over 2' x 2'), banners, rattles, klaxons or oversized hats
- Any objects or clothing bearing political statements or commercial identification intended for ambush marketing

Spectators are advised that the use of flash photography from the stands is strictly forbidden.

WIMBLEDON . LONDON. ENGLAND

We would strongly recommend that you plan your journey to Wimbledon in advance, taking into account that roads and public transport servicing The Championships will be heavily congested, and extra time may be needed to complete your journey.

The closest Underground Station to your hotel that will get you to Wimbledon is the Hyde Park Corner Station. It is a 10 minute walk from your hotel to the Hyde Park Corner Station and you will get on the Piccadilly Line (Blue Line) to Earl's Court Underground Station which will take approximately 7 minutes. You will need to get off and then take the District Line (Green Line) which will take approximately 14 minutes to The Championships (Southfields Underground Station). Please note to get on the District Line (Green Line) that says Wimbledon as its destination.

There will be no Southfields bus shuttle service in 2016 from the Southfields Underground Station to The Championships. This supports the aim of reducing traffic congestion along Wimbledon Park Road to create a more pleasant arrival experience at The Championships. An Accessibility Shuttle will remain available from Southfields for those who might experience difficulty in walking to the Grounds.

Walking times are approximately as follows:

- 5 minutes to the entrance of Wimbledon Park where the Queue is located
- 15 minutes to the Grounds (Gate 1)
