IDENTIFYING YOUR PEST PROBLEM

Identifying your pest problem is perhaps the most important part of the process. If your problem is misidentified from the beginning, the treatment and preventative measures that follow won't be very effective. Misidentification could take your small pest problem and turn it into an out of control pest problem.



When identifying your pest problem, your pest service company should be able to:

- Identify any pest, based on its physical appearance, the clues it leaves around your home, or its habits.
- Identify the why behind your pest problem. They should work hard to track down the source of your problem whether it be a crack in your foundation providing entry or an available, attractive, and abundant food source you likely didn't know was there.
- Identify the full extent of your problem and answer questions like, "How many pests are we looking at? Have the pests nested yet? Have the pests spread throughout the home?" Knowing the full extent of the problem will help later when deciding the best course of treatment and future preventative measures needed.

Does your pest control company have dogs?

Bed bugs don't stand a chance against our expertly trained K9s. When it comes to identifying a bed bug problem, the Killingsworth K-9 team has a 98% success rate, whereas humans identify only about 30% of bed bug issues.

Our three-part bed bug removal plan brings the pups in first to detect, uses a process of thermal remediation to take them all out, and then brings the dogs back in to ensure the bugs are actually all gone.

TREATING YOUR PEST PROBLEM

Once your problem is accurately identified, the next step is to determine the best, most effective course of treatment to rid your home of the pests.

An effective pest treatment won't just take care of your visible pest issue, it will take care of your entire pest issue. (We're talking about those stubborn pests hiding in the deep, dark depths of your home – oh, and don't forget about the eggs your pests laid!)

If your problem isn't treated entirely it will come back and likely come back worse than before! We don't think there's anything more frustrating, do you?

When treating your pest problem, your pest service company should:

- Know pest treatment options well! They should know which treatments will work and which ones won't.
- Make your family's health and well-being a TOP priority whether it be getting that pest out, and out fast, or with the chemicals and treatment
