Privacy Policy

At Display Pack Inc. (DPI) we value the privacy of our visitors. We use the information we collect about you to process transactions, to provide better service, and ultimately a more personalized experience. Please read on for more details about our privacy policy.

Information collected on www.displaypack.com and its pages (the "Site") will be used according to the following guidelines:

- DPI may collect individually identifiable information, and other information that can be associated with an
 identifier, in order to provide information and services to website users, and to allow DPI to (i) analyze and
 monitor consumer and customer activity; (ii) promote and support our products and services; and (iii)
 develop a knowledge base regarding the Site users and customers. Do not submit information to the Site
 that you do not want DPI to access.
- 2. DPI may use "cookies" or similar technology to keep track of our customers and the goods or services they are ordering. If you do not wish to accept cookies, the "help" selection on your browser's toolbar will likely tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting cookies, how to have the browser alert you when you receive a new cookie, or how to disable cookies altogether. - 5. We may use your information to notify you occasionally about important changes to this Site, new DPI services and special offers. If you would rather not receive this information, please contact us by using the feedback function on our Site. Be sure to notify us for each e-mail address you have provided.
- 6. To improve the products and services offered, DPI may share data collected on the Site with website designers and other parties that provide support services for the website. This is generally aggregate data that is anonymous in nature. If we provide any individually identifiable information, it will be upon terms that prohibit these service providers from making any independent commercial use of individually identifiable information and that prohibit them from sharing the data with third parties or otherwise making it publicly available.
- 7. DPI uses commercially reasonable means to protect the integrity of our websites and the confidentiality of collected data. Thus, if you place an order with us, we will use encryption techniques to protect the security of the transmission. DPI cannot provide absolute assurances against, and will not be liable for, breaches of confidentiality due to system failures or unauthorized access by third parties. It is your responsibility to keep your password confidential and not share it with anyone. If you share a computer with someone, you should always log out before leaving the Site to protect the confidentiality of your information.
