## Training delivery

### Workplace or virtual campus (13 months)

Our workplace delivery mode is designed for anyone who is currently employed in a school age education and care service. Virtual campus is for anyone who is **not** currently employed in a school age education and care service.

**Practical placement** — A minimum of 240 hours in at least one regulated school age education and care service is required for this qualification. We help arrange placement for students who are not already employed in a school age education and care service.

## Requirements and funding

### Entry requirements ✓

- Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) skills meet the standards for the diploma study level
- A current Working With Children Check is required for practical placement
