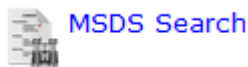


Print Label

(M)SDS labels can be printed for any (M)SDS if NFPA, HMIS, and/or WHMIS data is being captured. If you use the identified label stock, your labels should be printed accurately. GHS labels are not part of this package, but instead part of [GHS](#) in the SafeTec system.

1. On the Admin Main Menu click **MSDS Search**.



2. Search for the product to create a label for and click the **Search** button.

3. Click on the product name.

4. On the MSDS detail page, click the **MSDS Labels** tab.



5. Select a label that works with your label stock. Please note that there are several pages worth of templates to choose from.

6. Select the location for the label to appear on the label stock. For sheets with more than one label, entering a number or a range of numbers will permit labels to only be printed in those label cells instead of the whole sheet. Leave it blank to print on the entire sheet.
