

- b. Use the **Regulation** drop down menu to see an entire list of Regulations loaded in your system and make a selection.





Create a Regulation






Modify a Custom Regulation List of Substances



My Regulations

SafeTec allows a user to mark a regulation as important using with **My Regulation**. Users can develop a collection of regulations with **My Regulations** and search just through these indicated regulations.

Indicate a Regulation as My Regulation

There are three ways to flag a regulation in My Regulations.

1. From the Main Menu, click on **Regulation Management**.




2. On the **Regulations Management** page, either search for a regulation or browse the regulation list for a regulation you want to mark with **My Regulation**.
3. **Option 1:** If you have found a regulation in the list and you are confident you want to mark it as **My Regulation** without reviewing the regulation, click the blue **Add** button to the right of the regulation.
