

OneFile and Moodle

Single sign-on

Our OneFile and Moodle integration allows users to log in to Moodle using their OneFile credentials. In the single sign-on process, if an account doesn't already exist on Moodle, it will be created and the user will be logged in. Links can then be created in OneFile to resources in Moodle.

To enable this feature, users must install a “log in with the OneFile” button on their Moodle login portal.

Creating the integration

- Download the plug-in. You'll need be a Moodle admin to do this. The plug-in can be found by clicking the Moodle icon on the OneFile Integrations page.
- Install the plug-in on your Moodle site. To do this, locate the Moodle authfolder on the server of your Moodle installation and paste your unzipped OneFile authfolder there.
- Log into Moodle as an admin.
- Upgrade the database by clicking the 'upgrade Moodle database now' button and then enable the onefileauth plug-in.
