## VERMONT FEDERAL CREDIT UNION COLLECTS DONATIONS FOR THE CHITTENDEN EMERGENCY FOOD SHELF THROUGH THE ANNUAL FEED YOUR NEIGHBOR EVENT

Burlington, VT – On Saturday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, Vermont Federal Credit Union was the presenting sponsor of the Feed Your Neighbor Food Drive to benefit the Chittenden Emergency Food Shelf.

Vermont Federal Credit Union joined radio stations 99.9 The Buzz and 106.7 WIZN at Costco in Colchester to support the Feed Your Neighbor Food Drive for the 10<sup>th</sup> consecutive year. Credit Union staff spent the day collecting non-perishable food items as well as cash donations to benefit the Chittenden Emergency Food Shelf. Staff volunteers provided suggested items to donate and those who contributed received reusable Vermont Federal tote bags as a thank you.

This year's food drive raised 5,130 pounds of food and \$610 in cash, equating to 1,830 additional pounds of food for a total of 6,960 pounds donated. This is an increase of over 650 pounds from the previous year's event.

Vermont Federal is a \$500 million-plus financial institution, with six locations currently serving over 36,000 members. Members are part of a cooperative, meaning they share ownership in the Credit Union and elect a volunteer board of directors.
