

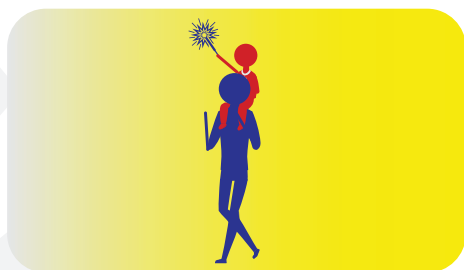


SPARKLER SAFETY



6 FEET APART

- Stand while using sparklers.
- Stay 6 feet apart with sparklers at arm's length and away from your body.



CHILDREN

- Do not hold children while they are using sparklers.



ONE AT A TIME

- Do not hand a lit sparkler to someone or light more than one at a time.



WATER

- Place used sparklers in a bucket of water after using them. The stick or wire end may remain hot for a period after use.



SHOES

- Wear closed-toe shoes.



SUPERVISION

- Always have adult supervision.



DO NOT RUN

- Do not run with sparklers.



DO NOT THROW

- Do not throw sparklers.

TIPS TO FOLLOW TO ENSURE A FUN, SAFE HOLIDAY WITH FIREWORKS:

- Always read and follow directions from the label.
- Make sure an adult is present.
- Only use fireworks outside.
- Keep water hand - a garden hose and a bucket of water.
- Never experiment with or make your own fireworks.
- Only light one firework at a time.
- Never re-light a "dud" firework (wait 15 to 20 minutes) after trying to light it, then soak it in a bucket of water).
- Small children should never have access to fireworks.
- If you aren't using the fireworks right away, it's best to store them in a cool, dry place.
- When the fun is over, dispose of fireworks properly by soaking them in water. Dispose of the fireworks in a trashcan 24 hours after lighting.
- Never throw or point fireworks at other people.
- Never carry fireworks in your pocket.
- Never carry fireworks in metal or glass containers.
- The person lighting the fireworks should always wear eye protection and should never lean over the firework.
- Stay away from illegal explosives.
