As designed, the project provides immersive, engaging study guides, hands-on activities and funding for materials to spark curiosity in students. The project asks that participating schools incorporate the *Design Challenges* into their classrooms and provide quantitative and qualitative feedback to strengthen the impact of TPBL. The project and associated research collection and analysis are scheduled to take within **February to June 2020**, with the online *P3 Applied* course and associated workshops occurring in March 2020.
